STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and one, entitled writ for replevying a person, and chapter one hundred and thirty-five, entitled sentence and its execution in criminal cases, and the liberation of poor convicts, of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section third of chapter one hundred and
- 2 one of the revised statutes is hereby amended by in-
- 3 serting in the third line, after the word "sheriff," the
- 4 words "or his deputy."
 - Sect. 2. Section ten of chapter one hundred and
- 2 thirty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amended.

- 3 by inserting between the word "to" and the word
- 4 "and," in the seventh line, the following words:
- 5 "which oath may be administered by the sheriff, jailer,
- 6 or any justice of the peace or trial justice."
