STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT in addition to an act approved March nineteen, eighteen hundred and sixty-two, entitled an act to regulate agencies for, and to prevent imposition in the sale of intoxicating liquors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The commissioner provided for in the

- 2 act approved March nineteen, eighteen hundred and
- 3 sixty-two, entitled an act to regulate agencies for, and
- 4 to prevent imposition in the sale of intoxicating liquors,
- 5 may sell to duly authorized agents of cities and towns
- 6 in other states, under the same duties and penalties as
- 7 are now provided for the regulation of sales to agents
- 8 in this state.
