STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT in relation to the collection of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

That chapter six of the revised statutes of this state
2 be amended by striking out section eighty-two in said
3 chapter and substituting the following, to wit :

SECT. 82. The voters of a town at their annual town
2 meeting for the election of town officers may choose a
3 collector or collectors of taxes and agree what sum
4 shall be allowed as a compensation for the performance
5 of their duties ; but if none are chosen, or if those
6 chosen refuse to serve or give the requisite bonds, the
7 assessors may appoint a suitable person to act as con-
8 stable and collector for the collection of taxes.
