STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT in relation to the collection of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That chapter six of the revised statutes of this state

- 2 be amended by striking out section eighty-two in said
- 3 chapter and substituting the following, to wit:
 - Sect. 82. The voters of a town at their annual town
- 2 meeting for the election of town officers may choose a
- 3 collector or collectors of taxes and agree what sum
- 4 shall be allowed as a compensation for the performance
- 5 of their duties; but if none are chosen, or if those
- 6 chosen refuse to serve or give the requisite bonds, the
- 7 assessors may appoint a suitable person to act as con-
- 8 stable and collector for the collection of taxes.
