STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section three of chapter one hundred and thirteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, relating to taxes upon certain towns and plantations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section three of chapter one hundred

- 2 and thirteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred
- 3 and sixty-two, is amended, by adding thereto the
- 4 words following: "And any prior organization of
- 5 any such plantation for election purposes shall cease
- 6 to have any legal effect; and the officers chosen under
- 7 the organization provided for in this section, shall, as
- 8 soon as may be, be qualified to discharge the duties of

- 9 their respective offices; and for failure to do so, shall
- 10 be subject to the penalties provided in such case in
- 11 chapter three of the revised statutes for town officers."

 Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved

 2 by the governor.
