STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section three of chapter one hundred and thirteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, relating to taxes upon certain towns and plantations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter one hundred
2 and thirteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred
3 and sixty-two, is amended, by adding thereto the
4 words following : “And any prior organization of
5 any such plantation for election purposes shall cease
6 to have any legal effect ; and the officers chosen under
7 the organization provided for in this section, shall, as
8 soon as may be, be qualified to discharge the duties of

9 their respective offices ; and for failure to do so, shall
10 be subject to the penalties provided in such case in
11 chapter three of the revised statutes for town officers.”

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved
2 by the governor.
