STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to regulate the liability of towns for damages caused by defective ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. In actions against a town for damages

- 2 arising from defects in ways, which the town is, by
- 3 law, bound to keep in repair, the plaintiff shall be
- 4 entitled to recover, when it shall appear to the satis-
- 5 faction of the jury, that the injury suffered did not
- 6 arise from the fault or negligence of the plaintiff or
- 7 any one in his employment, or under his control, and
- 8 that it would not have occurred but for the defect in
- 9 the way; and the plaintiff shall not be required to
- 10 prove that the defect in the way was the sole cause of

- 11 the injury: and it shall be the duty of the judge pre-
- 12 siding at the trial, to give instructions in accordance
- 13 herewith.
 - SECT. 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed
 - 2 to vary or impair or declare the rights, duties or liabil-
 - 3 ities of towns in respect to ways, except so far as
 - 4 expressly provided in the preceding section.
