#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and thirty-nine of the public laws of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-four.

Be it enacted by the Sena'e and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and
- 2 thirty-nine of the public laws, passed in the year of our
- 3 Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, is
- 4 hereby amended by adding thereto the words following,
- 5 viz: And if an action is brought against any town
- 6 on any claim mentioned in this act, any ten or more
- 7 taxable inhabitants thereof, by leave of the court, may,
- 8 at the expense of such town, employ counsel to defend
- 9 it; and if judgment has heretofore been, or hereafter

- 10 shall be, rendered in any such action, by default or
- 11 otherwise, any ten or more taxable inhabitants of the
- 12 defendant's town may petition the court for review of
- 13 said action in the name of the town, and employ
- 14 counsel at the expense of the town to prosecute said
- 15 proceedings in review to final judgment.
  - Sect. 2. Section two of this chapter shall be
  - 2 amended by adding thereto the words following: And
  - 3 when the proper authorities of any town refuse to
  - 4 institute any suit contemplated by this section on
  - 5 demand by any ten taxable inhabitants thereof, the
  - 6 latter shall have the power to bring such suit in the
  - 7 name and at the expense of the town.
    - Sect. 3. Town officers shall have no authority over
  - 2 any action or cause of action, or proceeding in review
  - 3 commenced by virtue of this act.
  - Sect. 4. This act shall take effect upon its 2 approval.
