STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT authorizing the county commissioners of Washington county to lay out and establish in East Machias a county road over tide waters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Authority is hereby given to the county
2 commissioners of the county of Washington to lay out
3 and establish, in the mode provided by existing laws,
4 a county road leading from the village of East Machias
5 to Machiasport, over or near the present location of a
6 town way between said points, so far over tide waters
7 as may be required to give the said road a sufficient
8 width and to make it a convenient highway.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved
2 by the governor.
