STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Easton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The plantation of Fremont, in the county 2 of Aroostook, is hereby incorporated into a town by 3 the name of Easton, and the inhabitants of said town 4 are hereby vested with all the powers, privileges and 5 immunities, and subject to all the duties and liabilities 6 of other towns under the laws of the state.

SECT. 2. Any justice of the peace within and for 2 said county, is hereby authorized to issue his warrant 3 to some inhabitant of said town, directing him to 4 notify the inhabitants thereof, by posting up copies of 5 the same in three public conspicuous places in said

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6 town, seven days at least before the time therein 7 named, to meet at such time and place as he shall 8 appoint, to choose such officers as other towns are au-9 thorized to choose at their annual meetings.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force 2 from and after its approval.
