REPORT.

LAND OFFICE, December 1, 1877.

To the Honorable Governor and Council:

In compliance with the provisions of law, I herewith submit the Annual Report of the operations of the Land Department during the past year.

On the thirtieth day of December, 1876, Edwin C. Burleigh, then holding the office of Land Agent, resigned the same, and Hon. Fred E. Richards of Camden, was confirmed as his successor on the twelfth day of January following. Mr. Richards held the office until the seventh day of February last, at which time he resigned, and the undersigned was re-appointed to fill the vacancy, and re-entered upon the duties of the office on the seventh day of March following. The present Report embraces all the transactions of the Department during the entire year.

SETTLING LANDS.

During the past year there have been conveyed to persons holding certificates as settlers on the State lands 16,454.98 acres; to Swedish immigrants 1,968.59 acres; for cash 252.36 acres, and under Resolves of the Legislature 1,624.73 acres. There still remain certificates outstanding in cases where the parties are at work performing their duties, covering 112,805 acres, of which 8,865 acres were certificated during the past year, besides 3,104.96 acres conditionally conveyed to actual settlers in Perham plantation.

There still remain unsold and uncertificated 19,567 acres, some part of which is understood to be taken up and not yet reported to the office, but the larger part of which is of a character but poorly adapted to the purpose of settlement.

For a more particular description of these lands, reference is made to the schedules annexed to this report.

ISLANDS.

Under the acts of the Legislatures of 1876 and 1877, seventy-seven islands lying in the sea along the coast of Maine were sold during the past year, as appears in schedules annexed. Several remain which were withheld from sale on account of the uncertainty of title.

THE SWEDISH COLONY.

This colony formed by immigrants from Sweden, and settled principally in the plantation of New Sweden and its neighborhood, continues to thrive, and bids fair to become permanent. They are a very industrious, temperate and well disposed people, and a very useful and valuable addition to our population. Having become acclimated to their new homes they seem happy and contented, and their efforts are being abundantly repaid by the results of a rich harvest and other favorable effects. Their crops have been good and satisfactory, and they may be justly regarded as fortunate in the experiment they have made in exchanging a home in a foreign land for one among us.

ARCHIVES OF THE LAND OFFICE.

Attention has been called several times in former reports of this Department to the plans and records of the Land Office, including those received by donation from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Under the authority of the resolve of 1874, chapter 286, during the past year these plans have all been carefully compiled, repaired and arranged, and then bound in a very convenient form for future use and

reference, filling seventeen large volumes. Careful indexes of each volume, and a general index of the whole have been made, so as to enable the examiner at a moment's call to find any one of the hundreds of maps thus collected. The records made by either the State of Maine or the Commonwealth of Massachusetts have, so far as possible, been arranged and filed, together with field notes of surveys.

The immense importance of these archives, thus arranged and preserved, can not be estimated. Their value is above all price, and they will furnish a never ceasing source of information and interest to every land holder and citizen of our State who is interested in its soil or title.

LOCAL AGENTS.

Under the provisions of section twenty-eight, chapter five of the Revised Statutes, the following persons residing in the vicinity of the public lands, were appointed "to superintend the location of settlers, the payment of their road labor, and the performance of their several duties :"
