*To the Honorable Governor and Executive Council:*

GENTLEMEN—In obedience to the laws of the State, I have the honor to submit herewith the annual report of the financial transactions of this department, as shown by the records in the office, for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1896.

**REVENUE AND TAXATION.**

The total amount of receipts in this office for the year 1896 were \$1,576,362.14 and the amount of disbursements for all purposes were \$1,663,102.26, which shows an excess of expenditures over receipts for the year, of \$86,740.12.

The receipts for the year 1895, as shown by my last report, were \$1,533,700.15 and the disbursements were \$1,701,655.30; the expenditures exceeding the receipts for said year, to the amount of \$167,955.15.

Therefore, the business of the Treasury for the past two years, shows an excess of payments over receipts, of \$254,695.27.

The fiscal year closes with a cash balance on hand of \$203,500.58.

The rate of taxation for the year 1896 was two and one-fourth mills on the dollar, yielding a total revenue from this source of \$731,941.70. Owing to the reduction in 1896, from the previous

year, of one-fourth of a mill in the rate of taxation, the amount of State tax assessed was \$81,130.60 less in 1896 than the amount assessed in 1895. Had the rate been maintained at two and three-fourths mills on the dollar as assessed for 1893 and for several years previous, the amount of the State tax assessed for the three past years would have been \$322,601.94 more than the amount assessed under the reduced rates for those years.

The tax assessed against cities and towns for the year 1895 has been paid in full.

#### BONDED DEBT.

When I assumed charge of the State Treasury, on the first day of February, 1895, the bonded indebtedness of the State was \$2,403,000.00, and at the present time it is \$2,303,000.00, which shows a reduction in the past two years, of \$100,000.00. Of this sum, fifty thousand dollars were paid in the year 1895, and a like amount in 1896.

There was also paid during the past two years, as interest on the bonded debt, the sum of \$149,380.00, of which, \$75,440.00 were paid in 1895, and \$73,940.00 were paid in 1896.

The aggregate sum, therefore, paid during the years 1895-6, as interest and toward the liquidation of the bonded indebtedness, is \$249,380.00.

#### TRUST DEPOSITS.

In my last report, I called attention to the fact that the Maine Mutual Life Insurance Company had gone into the hands of a Receiver but that the securities, placed here for the benefit and protection of its certificate holders, were still on deposit in this office. These securities, aggregating \$11,600.00 and consisting of  
 Coupon bonds St. Paul & White Bear R. R. Company, \$5,000 00  
 Notes secured by mortgages . . . . . 4,700 00  
 Certificates of stock in Ticonic Nat'l Bank, Waterville, 1,900 00  
 were delivered to Honorable James W. Wakefield, Receiver, on January 15, 1896.

The Granite State Provident Association of Manchester, N. H., has been thrown into the hands of a Receiver the past year, but the securities, as described in Table No. 9, are still on deposit in this office, subject to the order of the Court.



**TAX ON LANDS IN UNINCORPORATED PLACES.**

For several years past, there has been noticeable an inclination on the part of owners of small tracts of land in unincorporated places, mostly settlers, to neglect or avoid the payment of State and county taxes.

This is rendered somewhat easy in many cases by the lack of efficient laws bearing on the subject, and the difficulty in enforcing the penalties already provided.

The law provides that all wild lands on which the State and county taxes remain unpaid, shall be advertised and offered for sale in September of the second year after assessment. This law has been fully complied with, but very few bidders have been found for such tracts, because of the inability of the State Treasurer to give such a title as would secure recognition by the courts. These tracts are frequently scattered over a whole township, so that no accurate description of their location and bounds may be given in the deed of conveyance.

The legislature of 1895 passed a law authorizing the County Commissioners to appoint a collector for each of certain plantations, to collect such State and county taxes and pay them over to the County Treasurer, to be transmitted to the Treasurer of State.

A full compliance with this law would no doubt result in the accomplishment of its purpose as successfully as in the case of cities and towns. During the first two years of its operation, it has worked on the whole, fairly well. The counties of Oxford and Washington have paid in full the taxes of 1895 and 1896, and Franklin county has done nearly as well. Hancock and Penobscot have paid the tax of 1895.

Of the other three counties in which wild land plantations exist, two have paid a small portion of the tax of 1895, and one has made no return.

But although an energetic enforcement of the law above mentioned would result in the collection of taxes assessed since the year 1894, no provision is made for the collection of arrears, which in some cases, extend over a period of several years.

In 1887 a tax was imposed on the right to cut timber and grass on the public lots.

No penalty whatever is attached to the non-payment of this tax ; the soil being held in trust by the State for the benefit of the township in which it lies.

The ownership of these rights has been frequently transferred from one person to another, until it has, in many cases, been found impossible to ascertain the names of those who are responsible for the tax ; and even if this might be done, no payment could be forced from them.

I believe it to be for the best interests of the State to recommend such action by the present legislature, as will relieve the State Treasurer's books of these small but increasing delinquencies, and provide for the prompt payment of future assessments.

STATE HOUSE,

*To His Excellency, the Governor, and the Executive Council of the State of Maine:*

The undersigned, your committee appointed under the authority of section 71, chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes, to examine the accounts of the Treasurer of State for the year ending December 31, 1896, would respectfully report that they have carefully examined said accounts and find the same to correspond with the amounts as stated in his report. A correct voucher was found on file for each disbursement.

The amount of cash on hand at the commencement of the fiscal year, January 1, 1896, was \$290,240.70.

The receipts from various sources for the year 1896, were \$1,576,362.14, making a total of \$1,866,602.84. The expenditures for the year have been \$1,663,102.26, leaving a balance in the treasury on December 31, 1896, of \$203,500.58.

The bonded indebtedness of the State, January 1, 1897, was \$2,303,000, as follows: \$2,034,000 bearing 3 per cent interest; \$150,000 bearing 4 per cent interest; \$118,300 bearing 5 per cent interest, \$700 due October 1, 1889, not presented for payment. No temporary loan exists.

There has been paid during the past year \$50,000 on the bonded indebtedness, as follows: Registered bond numbered 418 for \$23,000, and registered bond numbered 420 for \$10,000 of the reissue loan of June 1, 1864, and registered bond numbered 417 for \$17,000 of the reissue loan of October 1, 1869.

Your committee January 28, 1897, in the presence of the State Treasurer, F. M. Simpson, destroyed by burning \$50,000 of registered bonds. Also \$2,000 of registered bonds, numbered 492 and 493, for which new registered bonds have been issued.

We have certified to the amount of each bond destroyed.

We have verified all trust deposits, a list of which appears in the treasurer's report.

We find the books and accounts neatly and systematically kept, which greatly facilitates the work of the committee. We feel that the citizens of the State of Maine may well be proud of their efficient treasurer, F. M. Simpson, and his competent corps of clerks. We take this opportunity to thank them for their courtesy and assistance.
