## REVIEW OF 1906 PRINTING.

---

At the time of closing the accounts for the 1906 report of this department there was in the hands of the printers, unfinished work authorized and commenced before the close of the year, estimated to cost \$6,066.42. When finished this work cost \$6,343.69, or \$277.27 more than the estimate.

With the known cost of the eleven items above referred to we are enabled to give the actual total cost of printing authorized in 1906 as \$26,953.66.

On following pages will be found the cost in detail of the printing authorized during 1907 for the various departments, institutions, bureaus and commissions, with but one item uncompleted, that being the annual report of the Adjutant General for the year 1906. Following the items in detail will be found the summary by departments. We also present the items and cost of printing required and authorized by orders of the legislature during the session of 1907. Below are the totals:

We consider two years a complete period in state printing matters because a considerable amount of work is required only biennially, and the demand for general printing is noticeably stimulated immediately following a session of the legislature. This has involved the figuring of 4,227 items in detail, varying in cost from a fifty-cent job to a book edition costing \$4,067.41. Each of these items had to be considered in its peculiar relation to a number of conditions—size of type, style of composition, number of ems in the printed area, class of press work, number of impressions required, color of ink, size, weight and quality of stock.

In this office may be found on file, arranged conveniently for immediate reference and available for public inspection, a sample and voucher for every job of printing involved in the above statement, and a detail invoice.

## STUDY OF CAUSES AND CONDITIONS.

---

Assuming that the public is interested and wants to know the facts about this branch of the public service, and with this knowledge will be the better able to direct through its representatives how this service shall be conducted, we state a few general facts that will give a more intimate knowledge of causes and conditions than can be gathered from the figures here published.

There are three principal causes for the saving in cost of printing. First, the lower rates obtained through competitive bids; second, the elimination of "constructive printing," so called; third, supervision in behalf of the State. Whether there has been any material change in the volume of printing, on the whole, as compared with former years, is a question hard to determine, from lack of available data for comparison.

The legislature of 1905 reduced to some extent the maximum limit on the editions of some department reports, and also extended the limit on others. Certainly the tendency is strongly toward an increase. New departments are being established and new duties are being imposed upon the older ones.

The printing requirements constitute a correct indicator of the activities of all branches of the State government. To cut off for a time the supply of printing would mean to clog the wheels of government and paralyze the public business. The tendency toward unavoidable increase in some directions emphasizes the need of constant restraint and careful pruning wherever it may be done without detriment to public service.

Every law passed by the legislature calls for more or less printing. Some laws set in motion a train of activities that call for a large amount of printing in a variety of ways.



## A STRIKING EXAMPLE.

A striking example of the above may be cited here. Chapter 174, Resolves of 1905, provides means whereby the State Assessors may employ "a competent person or persons whose duty it shall be to assist said board in verifying and perfecting, as far as practicable, a proper description of each parcel or tract of wild land, and the individual or corporate ownership thereof, in townships not incorporated, in order that such lands may be properly described for taxation purposes," etc. The legislature provided means for paying the person or persons thus employed, but did not foresee that a larger sum would be required to pay for the printing entailed by that "proper description."

In the State Assessors report for 1904 the valuation list made up for taxation purposes, covers 68 pages. Then the description of wild lands in unincorporated townships was by whole townships. In their report for 1906, in consequence of this "proper description of each parcel" the valuation list made 308 pages, increasing nearly five fold. This added to the cost of printing the report, \$979.50. (Item 1.)

When the legislature of 1907 came to assess a state tax this same "proper description of each parcel" entered into the cost of doing so. In 1905, House Document 574, assessing a state tax for 1905, contained 68 pages, and House Document 580, assessing a state tax for 1906, contained a like number of pages. In 1907 the corresponding Documents were numbered 673 and 676 respectively and contained 312 pages each. This increase in pages added to their cost \$1,053.04. (Item 2.)

We next come to the engrossed bill, in which form it must be finally passed and signed. The tax acts as engrossed for 1905 and 1906 contained 51 pages each. Those for 1907 and 1908 contained 260 pages each. This increase, which was more than five fold, made an additional cost of \$869.44. (Item 3.)

These same tax acts take their place among the laws of the commonwealth. In the 1905 volume of laws the two acts covered 48 pages each. In the 1907 volume the same covered 304 pages each—608 pages against 96. Here the increase is represented by the multiple six and one-third, and is responsible for additional cost of \$1,428.80. (Item 4.)

When the State Treasurer required these tax acts in pamphlet form to send to the municipal officers of each city, town and plantation in the state, eight hundred copies for each year had to be printed. The increased size over 1905 tax acts accounts for added expense of \$865.44. (Item 5.)

Again, it becomes the duty of the State treasurer, in obedience to law, to advertise wild land taxes in the state paper, and one paper in each of the eight counties in which wild land so taxed is located. Because of this "proper description of each parcel" these advertisements grew way beyond their usual size, making in some paper five or six pages of solid fine type. When the bills came in for these advertisements the state was indebted to the nine newspapers the sum of \$5,869.30. Heretofore \$900 has covered the cost of this advertising, so the tribute exacted by that resolve in this instance is at least \$4,969.30. (Item 6.)

We have given the results of the resolve only so far as it affects these principal items of printing and advertising in two years and have the following recapitulation:

It may be of interest to state here that through the co-operation of this office and that of the State Assessors a plan has been adopted for the forth-coming report whereby the description of wild lands will take a form that will reduce the space required from one-fourth to one-third, and also carry it into a class of composition costing only one-half as much per page. This will affect most of the above items and result in a saving of several thousand dollars.

## CONSTRUCTIVE PRINTING.

---

The apparently undue proportion of saving that appears in connection with Class A printing for 1906 is largely caused by several instances in which, under the old system, there would have been constructive printing, and which under the present system it was possible to eliminate. The same feature, in various ways and degrees, enters into all the other classes represented.

Touching this feature we quote from the report of the legislative committee on State printing, 1905:

“An important matter, to which our attention was also called, is the re-use of saved or standing type, and the printing ahead of more work than is ordered, in anticipation of other orders, and with the risk of loss, if the anticipation is not realized. The question was whether, in such cases, the printer is entitled to make a second charge for composition without having actually set up the type a second time. The overwhelming weight of the evidence was, and we accordingly find, that under a statute or contract containing no provision to the contrary, printers have a right to any savings accruing from standing type, or from printing ahead of orders; and we further find that when the present statute was enacted, the right of the public printer to such savings was considered by the legislature in fixing the statute rates. If the present statute is repealed, however, future contracts should express the understanding of the parties in this respect.”—Senate Document, No. 245, 1905.

By a sweeping provision in the contracts now in force, constructive printing, both in composition and press work, is entirely eliminated.

CONTRACTS FOR 1908 AND 1909.

---

Under date of Sept. 17, 1907, advertisements for sealed proposals for all or distinct portions of the State printing, for two years beginning Jan. 1, 1908, were mailed to all printing offices in the State, and inserted for one week in eight leading daily papers of the State. Specifications and forms for proposals were sent out to such printers as inquired for them. These specifications were much more elaborate in detail than those prepared two years earlier, covering such points as experience had shown might lead to misunderstanding on the part of the contractor, or controversy in the settlement of bills for printing.

The competition resulted in five proposals on class A, as follows: Burleigh & Flynt, Waterville Sentinel Pub. Co., Maine Farmer Pub. Co., Bath Times Co. and E. C. Bowler. On all of class B there were two proposals, those of Burleigh & Flynt and Waterville Sentinel Pub. Co. There were four other proposals on portions of class B, those of Wallace S. Ladd, Maine Farmer Pub. Co., Bath Times Co. and R. P. Harriman. There was but one proposal covering all of class C, that of Burleigh & Flynt. The Maine Farmer Pub. Co. and the Waterville Sentinel Pub. Co. made proposals on certain divisions of this class.

All proposals on class C, legislative printing, were rejected by the Governor and Council as being too high.

Under date of Jan. 1, 1908, a second call for proposals on class C was issued. This notice was inserted for one week in five leading daily papers. This competition resulted in one proposal on all of the class by the Waterville Sentinel Pub. Co. and another on a portion of the class by Burleigh & Flynt. These proposals were all rejected for the same reasons as were those received under the first call.

A third call for proposals on class C was issued under date of Jan. 28, 1908. The advertisement was published for one week in eight daily papers. One proposal, that of Burleigh & Flynt, was received, covering every division in class C. While

this proposal was lower in price than any other proposal under the three calls, it was somewhat higher than former prices for this class of work. Conditions and requirements attendant upon this class of the State printing seem to render proposals largely non-competitive.

Awards have been made and contracts entered into for printing for 1908 and 1909, as follows:

## LAWS RELATING TO STATE PRINTING.

*Reports, etc. Number to be printed.*—Revised Statutes, chap. 3, sections 24 and 25, as amended by chap. 138, Public Laws of 1905.

Section 1. That sections twenty-four and twenty-five of chapter three of the revised statutes be and are hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

‘Section 24. The number of copies of the following named reports to be printed hereafter at the expense of the state shall be determined by the governor and council but shall not exceed the following numbers: The report of the commissioner of agriculture, six thousand copies annually; the report of the bank examiner, two thousand copies; the report of the commissioner of the bureau of labor and industrial statistics, four thousand copies; the report of the officers and trustees of the State School for Boys, fifteen hundred copies annually; the report of the Industrial School for Girls, fifteen hundred copies annually; the report of the officers and trustees of the state prison, fifteen hundred copies annually; the report of the commissioners on the contagious diseases of animals, two thousand five hundred copies annually; the report of the University of Maine, fifteen hundred copies annually; the report of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station, one thousand copies annually; the report of the registrar of vital statistics, two thousand copies annually; the report of the insurance commissioner, two thousand five hundred copies annually; the report of the railroad commissioners, two thousand copies annually; the report of the state superintendent of public schools, four thousand copies on each legislative year, and three thousand five hundred copies on the alternate year; the report of the treasurer of the state, three thousand copies on each legislative year, and twenty-five hundred copies on the alternate year; the report of the trustees and officers of the insane hospitals, two thousand copies on each legislative year, and fifteen hundred copies on the alternate year; the report of the board of state assessors, four thousand copies on each legislative year, and three thousand copies on the alternate year; the report of the attorney general, one thousand copies biennially; the report of the land agent and forest commissioner, three thousand copies biennially; the report of the state board of health, forty-five hundred copies biennially; the report of the adjutant general, twelve hundred copies annually; the report of the librarian of the Maine state library, one thousand copies biennially; the report of the Bath Military and

Naval Orphan Asylum, one thousand copies biennially. Of the above named reports seventy-five copies may be retained by the binder for public documents, and at least six hundred and seventy-five copies shall be delivered to the state librarian, by the binder, for exchange, library use and general distribution, and the balance of the number of each report shall be delivered to the head of the department or institution where it originated and was prepared for publication.'

'Section 25. The reports, catalogues and compilations of all state departments, bureaus, commissions and institutions, other than as enumerated in the preceding section, may be printed and bound, but the number and the styles in which the same shall be so printed and bound, at the expense of the state, shall be determined from time to time by the governor and council, who shall also fix the number of the same which shall be delivered from the bindery or printing office to the librarian of the state library.'

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

[Approved March 22, 1905.]

*Report of Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game.*—Revised Statutes, chap. 32, section 35.

\* \* \* \* 'They shall, on or before the thirty-first day of December of each year, report to the governor who shall cause three thousand copies of said report to be printed.'

*Report of Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries.*—Revised Statutes, chap. 41, section 1.

\* \* \* \* 'He shall make a detailed biennial report in the month of December, showing the amount of capital invested in, number of men employed in, value of products of, and any other information that he may be able to obtain relating to the sea and shore fisheries.'

*Bulletins and Circular Letters. Subject to Approval of Governor and Council.*—Revised Statutes, chap. 3, section 26, as amended by chap. 52, Public Laws of 1905.

'Sec. 26. Each department, bureau and institution may have printed at the expense of the state, bulletins and circular letters of inquiry and information, at such times and in such numbers as the officer in charge thereof may consider necessary, such order for printing to be subject to the approval of the governor and council.

Except as hereinbefore provided, no reports, catalogues or compilations shall be printed, stitched or bound by any department, bureau, commission or institution of the state, at the expense of the state, unless by virtue of special legislative provision therefor.'

*Competitive bids, etc.*—Public Laws of 1905, chap. 155.

'Section 1. The governor and council are hereby authorized to contract, in behalf of the state, on the basis of competitive bids, for the



printing of the reports, catalogues, compilations, bulletins and circulars, authorized to be printed under sections twenty-four, twenty-five and twenty-six, of chapter three, of the revised statutes, and for all other miscellaneous printing, now or hereafter authorized by law, for each department of the state government, including the legislative printing, but excepting the printing of reports of decisions. They may, in their discretion, call for bids, and contract separately, for distinct portions of the state printing but may reject any and all bids which they do not deem it in the interest of the state to accept, and may take such security as they deem necessary, if any, for the faithful performance of any contract hereunder. No such contract shall be for a longer time than two years.

Section 2. Sections twenty-seven, twenty-eight, twenty-nine and thirty of chapter three of the revised statutes, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect January first, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and six.'

[Approved March 24, 1905.]

*State Printing further defined, etc.*—Public Laws of 1907, chap. 32.

'Section 1. The terms 'state printing' and 'miscellaneous printing,' as used in chapter one hundred fifty-five of the public laws of nineteen hundred and five shall be deemed to mean all the printing and printed supplies for which the state shall be holden to pay.

Section 2. The governor and council may, at their discretion, contract from time to time, on the basis of competitive bids, for the making or delivery of the paper stock, engravings, electrotypes, dies, lithograph or other plates required in the execution of the state printing. No such contract shall be for a longer time than two years.'

[Approved March 6, 1907.]

*Auditor of State Printing.*—Revised Statutes, chap. 3, section 31.

'Sec. 31. The governor, by and with the advice and consent of the council, shall appoint an auditor of the state printing, to serve during their pleasure; he shall be an experienced practical printer. All bills for state printing shall be audited by him, for which he shall receive such compensation as the governor and council may deem just.'

*State Binding, competitive bids, etc.*—Public Laws of 1907, chap. 176.

Section 1. The governor and council are hereby authorized to contract, in behalf of the state, on the basis of competitive bids, for all the folding, stitching, ruling and binding for every department of the state government, for which the state is held to pay, except the revised statutes and reports of the decisions of the supreme judicial court. They may, in their discretion, call for bids, and contract separately, for distinct por-

tions of the state binding, but may reject any and all bids which they do not deem it in the interest of the state to accept, and may take such security as they deem necessary, if any, for the faithful performance of any contract hereunder. No such contract shall be for a longer time than two years.

Section 2. All bills for state binding shall be audited for approval by the auditor of the state printing.

Section 3. Sections thirty-two, thirty-three and thirty-four of chapter three of the revised statutes, are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This act shall take effect January first, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nine.
