To the Honorable Governor and Council:

In compliance with Chapter 2, Section 89 of the Revised Statutes I have counted the cash in the office of the Treasurer of State amounting to \$35,986.96 and the books of the office show deposits in the several banks of the State amounting to \$1,827,776.45, making a total cash on hand and in banks amounting to \$1,863,763.41 at close of business June 30, 1922.

The Treasurer may by law deposit state funds in the banking institutions of the state. On June 30, 1922 the sum of \$1,863,763.41 was on deposit in 120 banks and trust companies. Such banks pay interest at the rate of four per cent on time deposits and 2 1-2 per cent on daily balances. During the eighteen months covered by this report the Treasury has received \$118,270.73 as interest on deposits.

During the eighteen months the State has sold two bond issues:—\$1,750,000 Highway & Bridge Loan, and \$1,150,000 State Pier Bonds.

The Highway Loan is a 5 per cent bond dated August 5, 1921 issued in denominations of \$1,000 each, maturing \$100,000 in 1927-1931 inclusive and \$125,000 in 1932-1941 inclusive. This issue was sold to the Fidelity Trust Company of Portland, Maine and to Brandon, Gordon & Waddell of New York, jointly at 98.147.

The State Pier Bond issue is dated March 1, 1922 in denominations of \$1,000 each, maturing \$115,000 1933-1942 inclusive.

These bonds were sold in two lots, \$650,000 being purchased by the Fidelity Trust Company of Portland, Maine at 99.159 and \$500,000 being purchased at 99.299 by Brandon, Gordon & Waddell and Barr & Schmeltzer of New York, jointly. These bonds bear 4 per cent interest.

The total bonded indebtedness of the State June 30, 1922 is \$11,283,300.00. This amount includes unnegotiable bonds for \$268,300.00 which constitutes a part of the Trust Funds of the State and Civil War bond for \$500. which has never been presented for payment.
