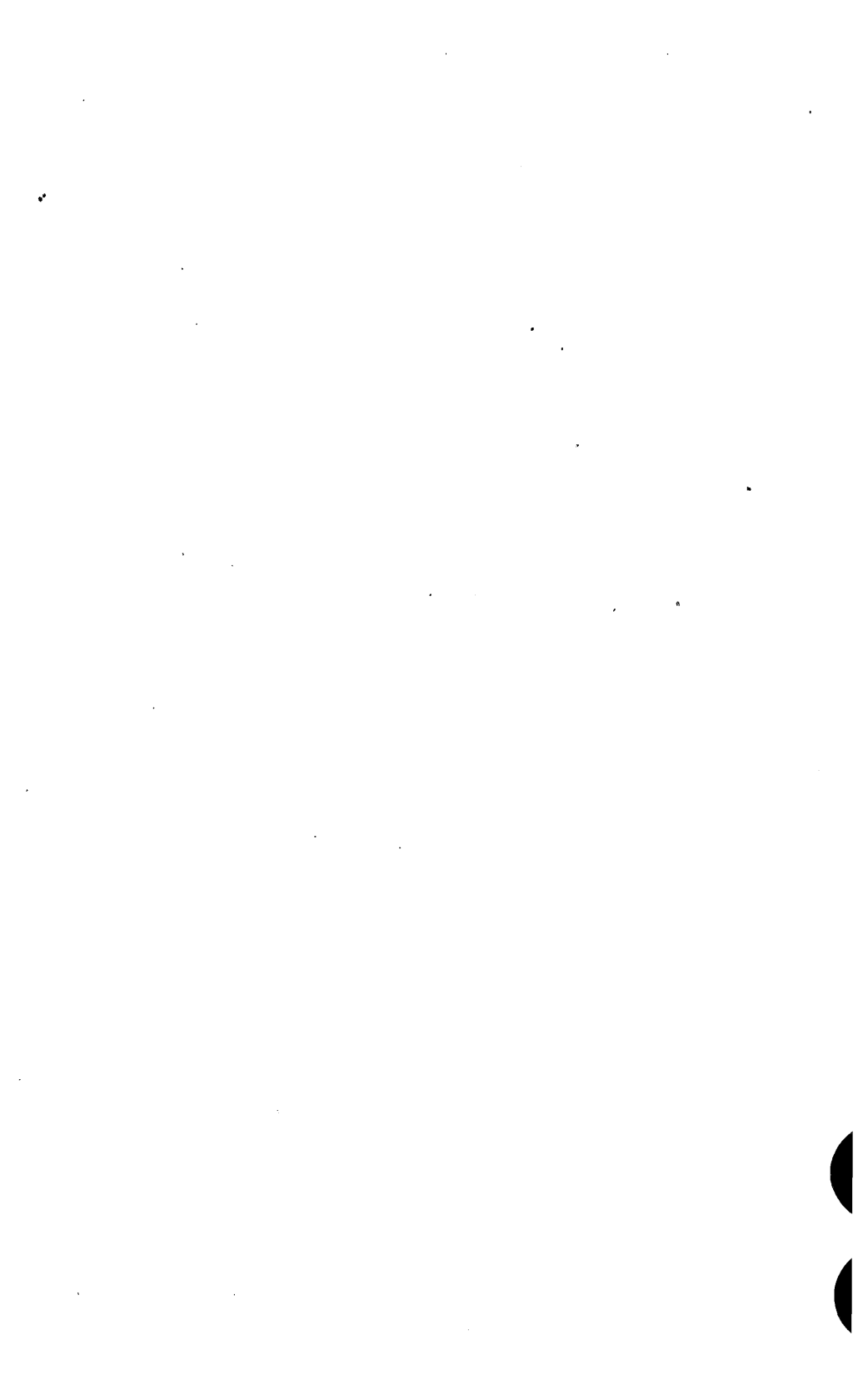

# REPORT

State Assessors' Office

Augusta, Maine, December 1, 1931

*To His Excellency, William Tudor Gardiner, Governor, and the  
Honorable Executive Council:*

Gentlemen:

In accordance with the Statutes of the State, we herewith submit for your consideration the Forty-First Annual Report of the Board of State Assessors, including tabulations of statistics returned to us by all municipal boards of assessors throughout the State, as made by them on April first, 1931, and lists of all corporations on which taxes have been assessed during the present year.

The total valuation of the cities, towns and plantations on April first, 1931, as made and returned by the local boards of assessors is \$650,652,433, representing an increase of \$4,998,895, as compared with similar returns on April first, 1930.

The following comparison is given of the counties in 1930 and 1931, exclusive of the unorganized townships:

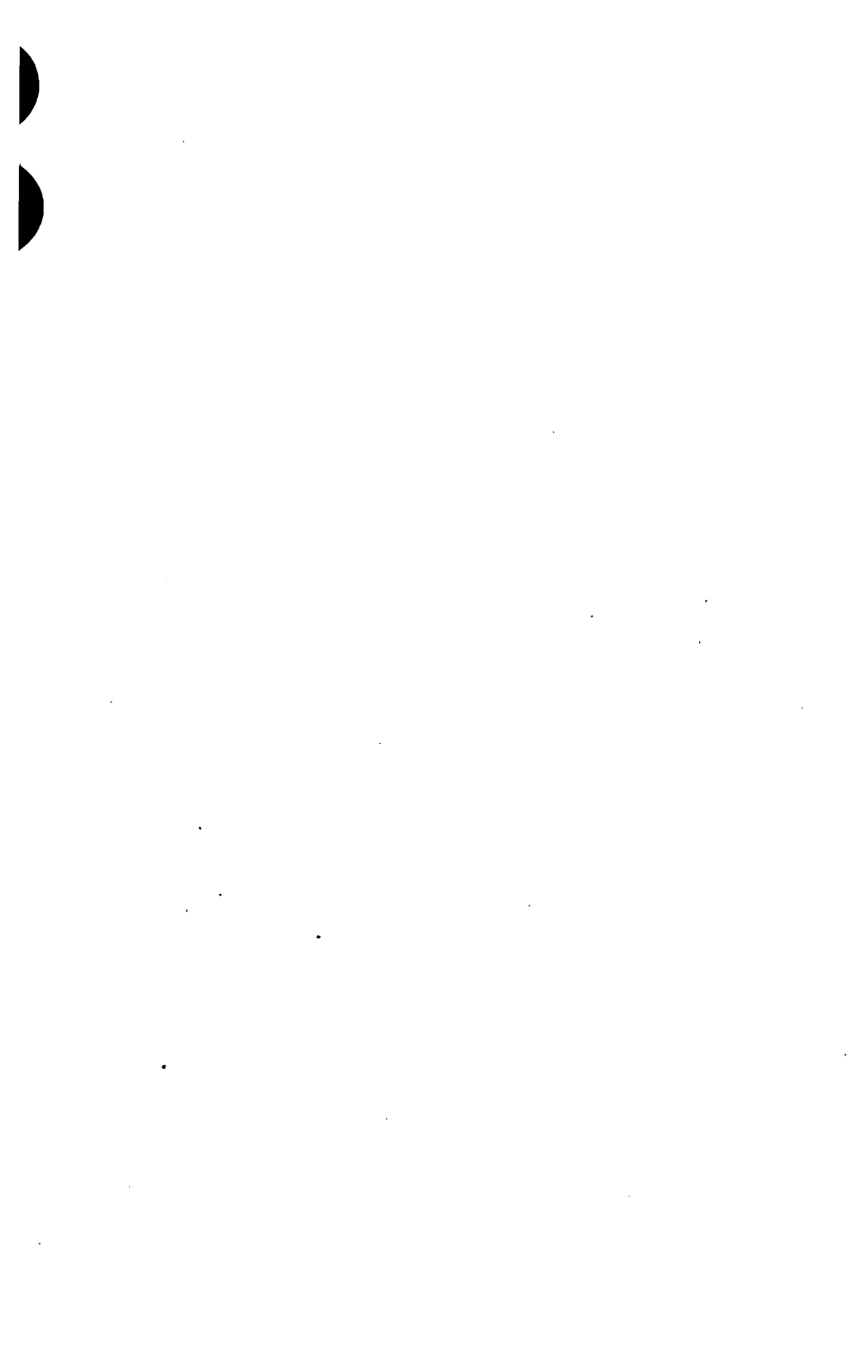
