REPORT OF DIVISION OF VITAL STATISTICS

Routine Office Work

The shipments of report transcripts to the Census Bureau were as follows:

Births 15,277. Stillbirths 493. Deaths 10,938.

Birth and death transcripts of non-residents 297.

Letters sent out 6,395. Letters received 5,471.

Records called for 11,743. Birth certificates sent out 15,119.

Corrections on Birth Certificates 716.

REGISTRATION REPORT, 1936

This report presents the results of the registration and tabulation of the births, marriages, divorces and deaths which occurred in the State of Maine during the year 1936.

The number of living births registered in the year 1936 was 15,342; 373 less than in the preceding year.

There were 167 twin-births and 1 triple-birth in 1936.

The number of stillbirths was 439.

The number of marriages (number of couples married in 1936) was 7,402; 304 more than in the preceding year.

The number of deaths recorded in the State for the same year was 11,314 (this number includes all premature deaths), a number 272 more than that of the deaths registered in the preceding year.

One thousand, four hundred and ninety-four divorces were decreed in the year 1936, 552 in 1892; 801 in 1900; 911 in 1910; 1,364 in 1920; 1,475 in 1930.

Bertillon Classification—Nomenclature of the causes of death in this report is the revised Bertillon classification adopted by the International Commission which met in Paris in 1930.

Population—The population of the State of Maine in 1910 as given by the census was 742,371; in 1920, 768,014; in 1930, 797,423.

During 1936, we have sent duplicate birth and death transcripts

of out of State residents with our monthly shipments to the Census Bureau. The Census Bureau acts as a clearing house, allocating to each state transcripts belonging to them.

Including our index cards, births, marriages and death records, also old records prior to 1892, we have filed over 70,000 cards during the year 1936.

During 1936 we have received several thousand copies of old records prior to 1892, from cities and towns where these records have been preserved. This made much extra work for our division as many were questioned as to their correctness.

The following is a general summary of the births, marriages and deaths in 1936.

ALLOCATION: Beginning with 1935, deaths are allocated to the place of residence of the deceased, having been charged in previous years to the place of death. This should insure as near a true rate as possible and have a marked effect on municipalities which are large hospital centers. These cities and towns have been charged with a high rate and small communities without hospital facilities have shown a low rate.

Births are charged to the residence of the mother, having been charged in previous years to the place of birth.

Deaths from automobile accidents are allocated to the place of accident or death.

Malarial Disease—Nearly every year a few deaths have been reported to the department as having been caused by malaria, or malarial disease.
