REPORT OF THE DIVISION OF VITAL STATISTICS  
FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1939

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Mailings of Transcriptions of Vital Records to the Census Bureau.

Births, 14,127. Stillbirths, 444. Deaths, 10,925

Births and deaths of non-residents, 313. To these items are added copies of 9,062 marriage records, a new assignment. The whole is a total of 34,871 records filed with the Census Bureau for the year 1939.

These items are not identical with the figures hereafter reported in tables for 1939.

FILES

Including the above items the whole number of vital records now on file at the Division of Vital Statistics is about 2,435,000.

GENERAL STATISTICS FOR MAINE, 1939

Live births, 15,135 (92 fewer than in 1938). These include 162 twin births and one triple-birth. (In each plural birth at least one child was born alive). There were 466 stillbirths. The whole number of marriages was 9,062 (1,244 more than in 1938). Of the total, 7,863 were marriages in which at least one of the parties was a resident of the State.

The number of deaths was 10,834 (339 more than in 1938).

The number of divorces was 1,449 (57 fewer than in 1938).

POPULATION

By official U. S. census the population of Maine

in 1920 was 768,014

in 1930 was 797,423

in 1940 was 847,226

The Census of April 1, 1940, proves a ten-year increase of 49,803, representing a 6.2% growth in the last decade as compared with a growth of 3.8 in the 1920-1930 decade.

For computing rates, populations are adjusted to July first of any year. Having available the 1940 census figures, the July 1, 1939 population is quite accurately estimated at 843,500. It

is on that base that rates for the state are reckoned. Tables involving rates for years previous to 1939 have been re-rated in accordance with re-estimated populations. These rates may be regarded as more accurate than those based on populations estimated before a later census was available. Several additional specific rate tables, not previously a part of this report, are also rated with re-estimated populations.

### ALLOCATIONS

Beginning with 1935, births and deaths have been assigned to the place of residence rather than to the place of occurrence. In 1939 upon the adoption of the Standard Certificates of Birth, Death and Stillbirth, the arbitrary rule of one year of residence to determine the allocation is replaced by the simple entry by physician or funeral director of "the usual place of residence" (In the case of a birth or an infant death, the residence is that of the mother).

### INTERPRETATION OF TABLES

- (1) The numbers quoted in this report, regardless of place of event, deal only with residents of the State.
- (2) Deaths and births are assigned to the place of usual residence.
- (3) The residence of an infant is that of its mother.

### RATES

The general rates of birth, death and marriage are rated as so many to each 1,000 population. Infant death rates and the puerperal (maternal) death rates are the number of such deaths to each 1,000 live births. Specific rates, those for separate death causes, are reckoned as so many to each 100,000 population.
