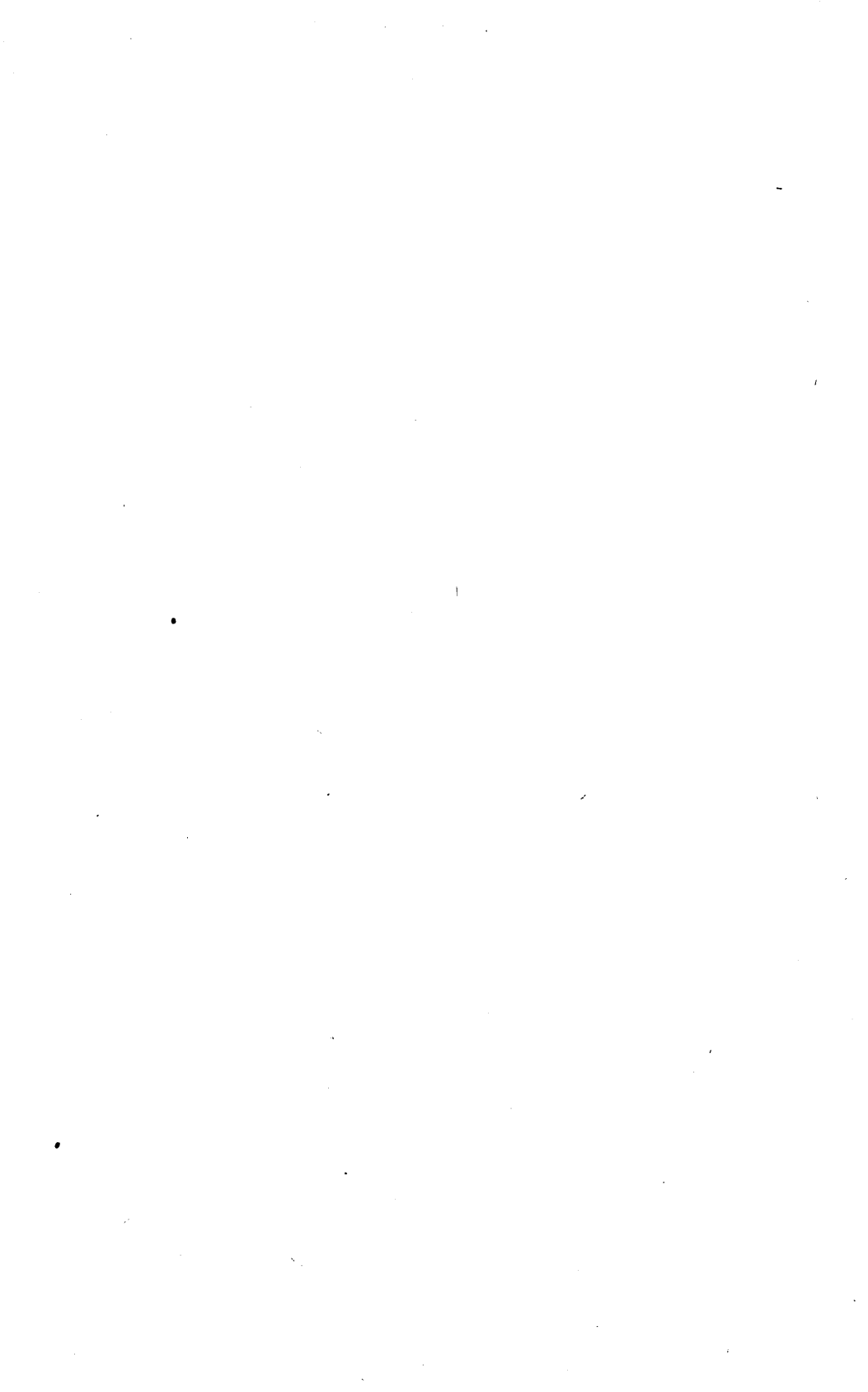

## REPORT OF THE DIVISION OF VITAL STATISTICS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1944

---

Mailings of Transcriptions of Vital Records to the Census Bureau.

Births 19,149; Stillbirths 272; Deaths 10,599.

Births to Non-resident Mothers 448; Deaths of Non-residents 262.

This is a total of 30,730 records filed with the Census Bureau during the calendar year 1944. These items are not identical with figures hereafter reported in the tables of the Annual Report.

From the Census Bureau there were received 496 records of births outside the State to mothers who were residents of Maine, and 273 records of death of Maine residents who died outside of the State.

### GENERAL STATISTICS FOR MAINE, 1944

Live Births 17,624 (1,264 fewer than in 1943). These include 179 plural births in which at least one child was born alive. In this number was one set of triplets. There were 397 Stillbirths. There were 6,849 Marriages (399 fewer than in 1943). Of Marriages in which at least one party was a resident of Maine there were 6,211 (425 fewer than in 1943). The number of Deaths was 10,302 (585 fewer than in 1943). The number of Divorces 2,176 (344 more than in 1943) was the greatest number ever recorded.

### POPULATION

By official U. S. Census the Population of Maine in

1920 was 768,014

1930 was 797,423

1940 was 847,226

War conditions have made the usual method of estimating current population too inaccurate for use. Instead, wherever possible, the number of food ration books has

been used. For towns where these figures are not available, the 1940 census returns have been used and where used the symbol ('40) is shown. The recent high birth-rate, which reached its peak in 1943, has begun to decline as predicted and this downward trend is expected to continue through 1945. The low death-rate for 1944 was common throughout the country. It should be understood that records of deaths in the armed forces are made available to the several states only if death occurred in the United States. Records of deaths overseas are not made available by the War Department.

Based on the fairly accurate estimation by food ration books, indicating a population of 836,797, the crude rates for the State per 1,000 population were:

Birth-Rate	21.1
Death-Rate	12.3
Marriage Rate	7.4

### ALLOCATIONS

Beginning with 1935, births and deaths have been assigned to the place of residence rather than to the place of occurrence. In 1939 upon the adoption of the Standard Certificates of Birth, Death and Stillbirth, the arbitrary rule of one year of residence to determine the allocation is replaced by the simple entry by physician or funeral director of the "usual place of residence". (In the case of a birth or an infant death, the residence is that of the mother.)

### INTERPRETATION OF TABLES

- (1) The numbers quoted in this report, regardless of place of event, deal only with residents of the State.
- (2) Deaths and births are assigned to the place of usual residence.
- (3) The residence of an infant is that of its mother.

### RATES

The general rates of birth, death, and marriage are given as so many to each 1,000 population. Infant death-rates and the puerperal (maternal) death-rates are the number of such deaths to each 1,000 live births. Specific rates, those for separate death causes, are reckoned as so many to each 100,000 population.
