## INTRODUCTION

---

### ALLOCATION OF VITAL EVENTS

Births and deaths have been allocated to usual place of residence rather than to place of occurrence since 1935. Usual place of residence is determined by the physician or funeral director who obtains information for the birth or death certificate. Thus the births, deaths, and stillbirths in this report are those of Maine residents regardless of place of occurrence. This system of allocation is made possible by the exchange of non-resident certificates with other states and with Canada.

Marriages and divorces are allocated to place of occurrence.

### MORTALITY CLASSIFICATION

In 1948 the World Health Organization adopted the Sixth Revision of the International Lists of Diseases and Causes of Death for use throughout the world. Prior to the introduction of the Sixth Revision the nosologist selected causes of death on the basis of a system of arbitrary rules. The Sixth Revision introduced an important change in that it did away with the system of arbitrary rules and introduced a system whereby the physician in attendance at the death selects the condition which he considers to be the underlying cause of death.

Use of the Sixth Revision unquestionably results in more accurate mortality statistics than those obtained by former classification methods. However, in view of the important change in concept between the Sixth Revision and former classifications, one should exercise extreme caution in comparing mortality tabulations before 1949 with those for 1949 and later years.

### POPULATION ESTIMATES

Since the 1950 Census was the latest complete enumeration of population, it is necessary to make estimates of population in later years for use as a base to compute rates. The population estimates included in this report are simple arithmetic projections based on the assumption that the population will continue to increase at the same rate at which it increased between the census years 1940 and 1950. This method is a rather limited one, and

one should not accept the results as the most accurate possible. However, the estimates obtained in this manner are adequate for the purpose of computing rates.

#### RATES

In accordance with standard practice birth and crude death rates are stated as the number of births or deaths occurring per 1,000 population. Infant, neonatal, and maternal deaths are stated as the number of deaths occurring per 1,000 live births. Death rates for specific causes are stated as the number of deaths occurring from a specific condition per 100,000 population.

## BIRTHS

Maine residents gave birth to 21,199 live born children in 1952, or 57 more than in the previous year. Maine's birth rate increased slightly from 22.9 in 1951 to 23.0 in 1952.

Plural births numbered 227 in 1952, including 224 sets of twins, two sets of triplets, and one set of quadruplets. This was the first set of quadruplets to be born in Maine since 1920, and the first set in which all four children survived.

The number of live born males in 1952 was 10,910, and the number of live born females was 10,289. This is a ratio of 106 males for every 100 females. This ratio is higher than is normal for Maine and is the highest ratio since 1947.

Stillbirths in 1952 numbered 373, or 17 more than in 1951.

## GENERAL MORTALITY

Nearly 200 fewer Maine residents died in 1952 than in 1951 and the number of deaths (9,942) was the smallest in the recorded history of vital statistics in Maine. The crude mortality rate continued its gradual decline and at 10.8 was at its lowest in history. The mortality rate for males was 12.2 and for females, 9.2.

## INFANT MORTALITY

Deaths among infants under one year of age were also at their lowest in history with respect to both number and rate. The number of infant deaths in 1952 was 637 and the infant mortality rate was 30.0.

## MATERNAL MORTALITY

Deaths among Maine women attributed to conditions arising from childbirth numbered 12 in 1952, or 4 fewer than in the previous year. The maternal mortality rate in 1952 was 0.6 per 1,000 live births.

## LEADING CAUSES OF DEATH

Diseases of the heart continue as the chief cause of death in Maine, closely followed by malignant neoplasms and vascular le-

sions of the central nervous system. These three causes accounted for slightly over two thirds of all deaths among Maine residents in 1952. Accidents were the fourth most important cause of death. The following table shows the ten leading causes of death among Maine residents in 1952:

### AGE ADJUSTED MORTALITY RATES

Table 5 contains age adjusted mortality rates as well as crude mortality rates for each county. These age adjusted rates are included for the purpose of facilitating comparisons in mortality in different areas in the state.

While the crude mortality rate is the most efficient measure of mortality in a given area, it is not the best statistic for use in making comparisons of the actual force of mortality acting on individuals living in different areas.

It is obvious that the probability of death is greater for an older person than for a younger one, therefore, the crude mortality rate will be higher in an area with a high proportion of elderly persons than it will be in an area with a low proportion of elderly persons, although the force of mortality may be the same for persons of the same age in both areas.

Age adjusted rates are theoretic rates from which the effects of the differing age characteristics of the areas which they represent have been removed. An age adjusted rate is obtained by applying the observed age specific rates in an area to their respective age groups in a standard population of 1,000,000. The number of "expected" deaths in this standard population constitute the age adjusted rate. The standard population used for computing age adjusted rates in this report is derived from the age distribution of the United States as enumerated in the 1950 census.

Although age adjusted rates resemble crude rates they should not be confused with them. An age adjusted rate is a theoretic rate and should be used only for the purpose of making comparisons with other age adjusted rates based on the same standard population.
