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## INTRODUCTION

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Certain tables which were formerly printed in this report have been omitted this year. Births and deaths are tabulated for each county and for 48 selected cities and towns rather than for each city and town in the state as was the practice in former years. The 48 cities and towns selected for separate tabulation are those places designated as urban in the 1950 Census of Population.

Should any person require information concerning vital statistics which does not appear in this report, he may obtain it by writing the State Registrar of Vital Statistics.

### ALLOCATION OF VITAL EVENTS

Tabulations of births and deaths appearing in this report concern residents of Maine only, regardless of whether or not the birth or death actually occurred in Maine. Births are allocated to usual residence of the mother and deaths to the usual residence of the decedent. This information is obtained by the physician, undertaker, or other person responsible for filing the birth or death certificate.

The practice of allocating births and deaths to usual place of residence was initiated in 1935. This system of allocation is made possible by the exchange of transcripts of non-resident births and deaths with other states and with Canada.

Marriages and divorces are allocated to the place where the marriage was performed or where the divorce decree was granted rather than to the place of residence.

### MORTALITY CLASSIFICATION

In 1948 the World Health Organization adopted the Sixth Revision of the International Lists of Diseases and Causes of Death for use in all participating countries. The Sixth Revision contains 612 categories of diseases and morbid conditions and 153 categories for the classification of the external cause of injury.

The Sixth Revision introduced an important change in the method for selecting the disease or morbid condition to which death is attributed for purposes of statistical tabulation. In earlier revisions, selections were made on the basis of a set of arbitrary rules. The Sixth Revision introduced a method whereby the physician in attendance at death indicated the disease or morbid condition which he considers to be the UNDERLYING cause of death. This is the condition to which death is attributed for purposes of statistical tabulation.

Use of the Sixth Revision has unquestionably resulted in more accurate mortality statistics than those obtained by use of older classification

methods. However, in view of the important change in the method of selecting the cause of death, it is essential that persons making use of mortality statistics exercise extreme caution in analyzing long time trends in specific causes of death.

The following table shows provisional changes in the number of deaths attributed to selected causes which arose as the result of the change in the method of classification. The change is expressed as the per cent increase or decrease in the number of deaths attributed to each selected condition upon the adoption of the Sixth Revision, and is based upon the 10 per cent national mortality sample.

Two abridged lists of causes of death are presented in this report. Deaths by selected age groups are tabulated in an abridged list of 254 causes and deaths by residence are tabulated in an abridged list of 65 causes.

#### POPULATION ESTIMATES

The population estimate for the State of Maine appearing in this report is prepared by use of the natural increase-estimated net migration method.

Population estimates for counties are prepared by apportionment of the estimated population of the State as a whole. In apportioning the populations of counties it was assumed that each county would retain the population growth pattern established between 1940 and 1950.

#### RATES

Birth and crude mortality rates are expressed as the number of births or deaths per 1,000 population. Mortality rates attributed to specific diseases are expressed as the number of deaths per 100,000 population.

Infant, neonatal, and maternal mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 1,000 live births.

Certain fluctuations may be expected in numbers and rates as a result of chance alone. Generally speaking, these fluctuations will tend to be greater in cases where smaller populations are involved than when larger populations are involved.

## **FACTORS AFFECTING ACCURACY**

A number of factors operate to produce certain slight inaccuracies in this report. Some of the more important of these factors are outlined below:

(1) **Completeness of registration:** A birth registration test conducted in 1950 indicated that about 1.2 percent of births in Maine are not recorded. In addition to unrecorded vital events, others may not be included in this report by reason of failure of the person required to report the event to make a timely report, or failure of a city or town clerk to make a timely report to the State Registrar, or failure of other states to make timely exchanges of non-resident transcripts of births and deaths.

(2) **Errors in Data:** Since the data from which this report is derived consists of copies of the original records of births, marriages, and deaths, two opportunities to introduce errors into the data are present. The person making the original record may make an erroneous entry on the record, or the person copying the record for the State Registrar may introduce errors in copying. Errors in either personal or medical information may be introduced in either way.

## POPULATION

The population of the State of Maine was estimated to be 924,000 on July 1, 1954. This represents an increase of about 10,000 over the population enumerated in the 1950 census. This estimate is based on an excess of 50,000 live births over deaths and an estimated net outward migration of 40,000 persons during the period between April 1, 1950 and July 1, 1954.

## POPULATION OF COUNTIES

## LIVE BIRTHS

The number of live births in Maine in 1954 was 22,439 as compared with 21,774 in 1953. The number of births in 1954 was the largest in any year since 1947, and was the second largest number in the history of the State, being exceeded only by the number born in 1947.

The birth rate was 24.2 in 1954 as compared with a birth rate of 23.2 in 1953.

The number of live births in hospitals and licensed maternity homes was 21,530 in 1954, or 95.9 per cent of all live births. This represents an increase of 3.5 per cent over the number of live births in hospitals and maternity homes in 1953.

There were 236 plural births in Maine in 1954, in which at least one child was born alive. All of the plural births in Maine in 1954 were twin births.

#### STILLBIRTHS

Children born dead after the 20th week of pregnancy numbered 364 in 1954 as compared with 388 in 1953.

#### DEATHS

The number of deaths in Maine in 1954 was 9,878 as compared with 9,817 in 1953. The crude death rate for Maine residents was 10.7 in 1954.

#### LEADING CAUSES OF DEATH

Suicide appeared for the first time as one of the 10 leading causes of death in Maine in 1954. Chronic and unspecified nephritis, and other renal sclerosis, which ranked as the 8th leading cause of death in 1953, dropped from the list into 11th position in 1954.

The following table shows the leading 10 causes of death in Maine in 1954.

## INFANT DEATHS

Deaths among infants under 1 year of age continued to decline in Maine in 1954. The number of infants dying in 1954 was 555 as compared to 570 in 1953. The infant mortality rate was 24.7 per 1,000 live births in 1954 as compared with 26.2 in 1953. There were 379 neonatal deaths (deaths under 28 days of age) in 1954 as compared with 390 in 1953, and the neonatal mortality rate declined from 17.9 in 1953 to 16.9 in 1954.

### LEADING CAUSES OF INFANT DEATH

Immaturity dropped from its usual first position among the leading causes of infant death into second position in 1954. The following table shows the five leading causes of infant deaths in Maine in 1954. These causes accounted for about three-quarters of all infant deaths in 1954.

## MATERNAL DEATHS

Deaths attributed to pregnancy, childbirth, and puerperium numbered 10 in 1954 compared with 8 in 1953. The maternal mortality rate in 1954 was 4.4 per 10,000 live births as compared with 3.7 in 1953.
