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INTRODUCTION

Certain tables which were formerly printed in this report have been omitted this year. Births and deaths are tabulated for each county and for 48 selected cities and towns rather than for each city and town in the State as was the practice in former years. The 48 cities and towns selected for separate tabulation are those places designated as urban in the 1950 Census of Population.

Should any person require information concerning vital statistics which does not appear in this report, he may obtain it by writing the State Registrar of Vital Statistics.

ALLOCATION OF VITAL EVENTS

Tabulations of births and deaths appearing in this report concern residents of Maine only, regardless of whether or not the birth or death actually occurred in Maine. Births are allocated to usual residence of the mother and deaths to the usual residence of the decedent. This information is obtained by the physician, undertaker, or other person responsible for filing the birth or death certificate.

The practice of allocating births and deaths to usual place of residence was initiated in 1935. This system of allocation is made possible by the exchange of transcripts of non-resident births and deaths with other states and with Canada.

Marriages and divorces are allocated to the place where the marriage was performed or where the divorce decree was granted rather than to the place of residence.

MORTALITY CLASSIFICATION

In 1948 the World Health Organization adopted the Sixth Revision of the International Lists of Diseases and Causes of Death for use in all participating countries. The Sixth Revision contains 612 categories of diseases and morbid conditions and 153 categories for the classification of the external cause of injury.

The Sixth Revision introduced an important change in the method for selecting the disease or morbid condition to which death is attributed for purposes of statistical tabulation. In earlier revisions, selections were made on the basis of a set of arbitrary rules. The Sixth Revision introduced a method whereby the physician in attendance at death indicated the disease or morbid condition which he considers to be the UNDERLYING cause of death. This is the condition to which death is attributed for purposes of statistical tabulation.

Use of the Sixth Revision has unquestionably resulted in more accurate mortality statistics than those obtained by use of older classification methods. However, in view of the important change in the method of selecting the cause of death, it is essential that persons making use of mortality statistics exercise extreme caution in analyzing long time trends in specific causes of deaths.

The following table shows provisional changes in the number of deaths attributed to selected causes which arose as the result of the change in the method classification. The change is expressed as the per cent increase or decrease in the number of deaths attributed to each selected condition upon the adoption of the Sixth Revision, and is based upon the 10 per cent national mortality sample.

Two abridged lists of causes of death are presented in this report. Deaths by selected age groups are tabulated in an abridged list of 254 causes and deaths by residence are tabulated in an abridged list of 65 causes.

POPULATION ESTIMATES

The estimate of the population of the State on July 1, 1956 which appears in this report is prepared by the U. S. Bureau of the Census.

Estimates of the population of Counties which appear in this report are prepared by independently estimating the population of each county by means of a method combining vital rates and arithmetic progression. The estimates prepared in this manner are then adjusted by a constant factor so that the sum of the population of counties equals the population of the State as a whole.

RATES

Birth and crude mortality rates are expressed as the number of births or deaths per 1,000 population. Mortality rates attributed to specific diseases are expressed as the number of deaths per 100,000 population.

Infant mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 1,000 live births. Maternal mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 10,000 live births.

Certain fluctuations may be expected in numbers and rates as a result of chance alone. Generally speaking, these fluctuations will tend to be greater in cases where smaller populations are involved than when larger populations are involved.

FACTORS AFFECTING ACCURACY

A number of factors operate to produce certain slight inaccuracies in this report. Some of the more important of these factors are outlined below:

(1) Completeness of registration: A birth registration test conducted in 1950 indicated that about 1.2 per cent of births in Maine are not recorded. In addition to unrecorded vital events, others may not be included in this report by reason of failure of the person required to report the event to make a timely report, or failure of a city or town clerk to make a timely report to the State Registrar, or failure of other states to make timely exchanges of non-resident transcripts of births and deaths.

(2) Errors in Data: Since the data from which this report is derived consists of copies of the original records of births, marriages, and deaths, two opportunities to introduce errors into the data are present. The person making the original record may make an erroneous entry on the record, or the person copying the record for the State Registrar may introduce errors in copying. Errors in either personal or medical information may be introduced in either way.

POPULATION

The population of Maine was estimated to be 930, 000 on July 1, 1956. This represents an increase of 1.8 per cent over the population enumerated in the 1950 Census.

POPULATION OF COUNTIES

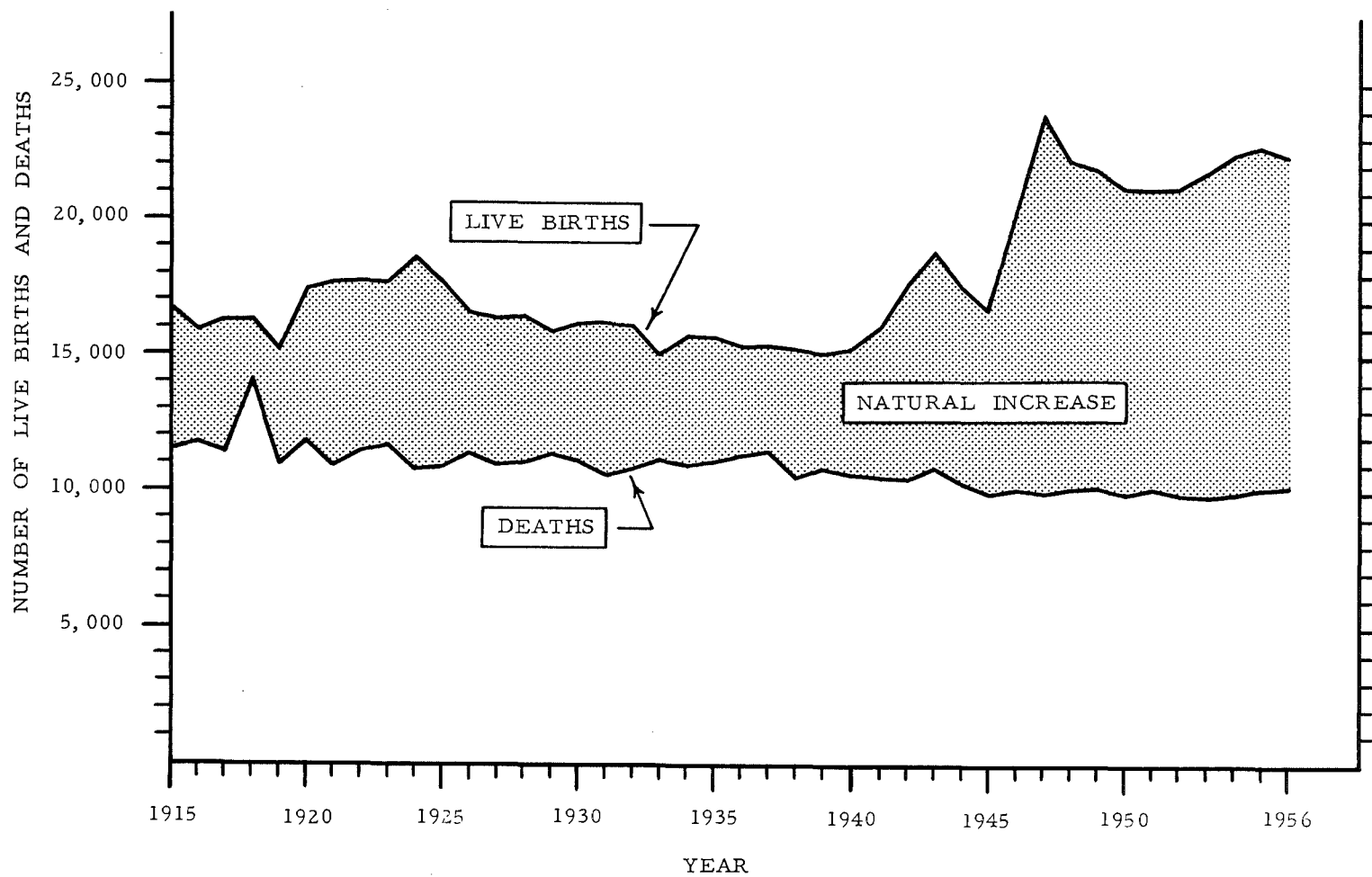

LIVE BIRTHS

There were 22,402 resident live births registered for Maine in 1956. This was 1.5 per cent fewer live births than in 1955. The birth rate in 1956 was 24.1 per 1,000 population.

SEX

The number of male live births was 11,450 and the number of female live births was 10,952. The sex rates was 104.5 male live births for every 100 female live births.

PLURALITY

There were 253 plural births in which at least one child was born alive in 1956. Plural births included 249 pairs of twins and 4 sets of triplets.

RACE

Less than 1 per cent of live births to Maine residents were to non-white residents. The total number of non-white live births was 148. The largest non-white group was the colored group with 75 births. American Indian births numbered 43, and residents of other non-white races gave birth to 30 children.

LEGITIMACY

There were 691 illegitimate live births to Maine residents in 1956. Illegitimate live births represented 3.1 per cent of total live births.

HOSPITAL BIRTHS

The percentage of live births occurring in hospitals and licensed maternity homes continued to increase. In 1956 the number of children born in hospitals and licensed maternity homes was 21,814 or 97.4 per cent of all live births. The percentage of hospital births in 1955 was 96.7.

FETAL DEATHS

Fewer fetal deaths were recorded in 1956 than in 1955. The total number of resident fetal deaths reported in Maine in 1956 was 577. This includes all fetal deaths regardless of the duration of pregnancy. The number of fetal deaths was about 10 per cent below the number of fetal deaths reported in 1955 and the fetal death ratio was 25.8 (fetal deaths per 1,000 live births) as compared with a fetal death ratio of 28.4 in 1955.

The following table shows fetal deaths in Maine by length of gestation in 1956 and the per cent change in each group from the number reported in 1955.

DEATHS

The number of resident deaths in Maine in 1956 was 10,183. This was the largest number of deaths reported in any year since 1944. The crude mortality rate was 10.9 per 1000 population, or the same as the crude mortality rate in 1955.

INFANT MORTALITY

Infant mortality was up slightly in 1956. The total number of infant deaths in 1956 was 560 and the infant mortality rate was 25.0 per 1,000 live births. This was slightly higher than the infant mortality rate in 1955 which was 24.5 per 1,000 live births. Neonatal mortality (infant deaths under 4 weeks of age) was up slightly with 401 neonatal deaths and a neonatal mortality rate of 17.9 per 1,000 live births as compared with a rate of 17.3 in 1955.

PERINATAL MORTALITY

The perinatal mortality rate is a relatively new measure of risk at birth. It is ascertained from the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{Fetal deaths over 20 weeks} + \text{infant deaths under 7 days}}{\text{Total live births} + \text{fetal deaths over 20 weeks}} \times 1000$$

The perinatal mortality rate experienced a decline in 1956. The estimated perinatal mortality rate was 30.0 in 1956 as compared with 31.5 in 1955. This rate is based on an estimated 335 fetal deaths over 20 weeks gestation and 355 infant deaths under 7 days of age.

MATERNAL MORTALITY

There were 14 resident maternal deaths in Maine in 1956 and the maternal mortality rate was 6.2 per 10,000 live births. This was the largest number of maternal deaths in any year since 1941.

MARRIAGES

There were 8176 marriages which took place in Maine in 1956, or 87 fewer than the number of marriages in 1955. Among these marriages were 5960 in which both the bride and groom were marrying for the first time.

There were more resident brides married in Maine than resident grooms. The number of marriages in which the bride was a resident of Maine was 7,632 while the number of resident grooms 6,772, or nearly 1,000 fewer. Among those marrying in Maine in 1956 were residents of every state, the District of Columbia, Hawaii, Canada, and several other foreign countries.

DIVORCES AND ANNULMENTS

There were 1918 absolute divorces and 8 annulments of marriages granted by the Superior Court in Maine in 1956. This was the smallest number of divorces issued in any year since 1943.

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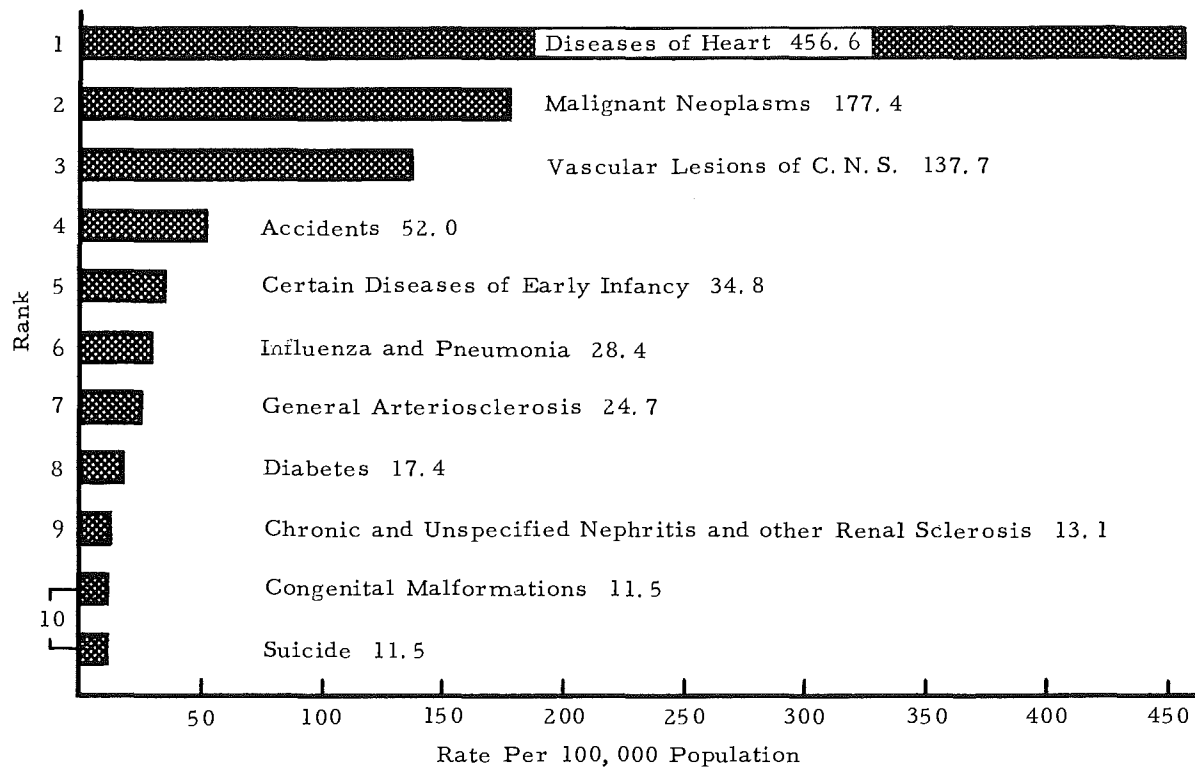

TEN LEADING CAUSES OF DEATH

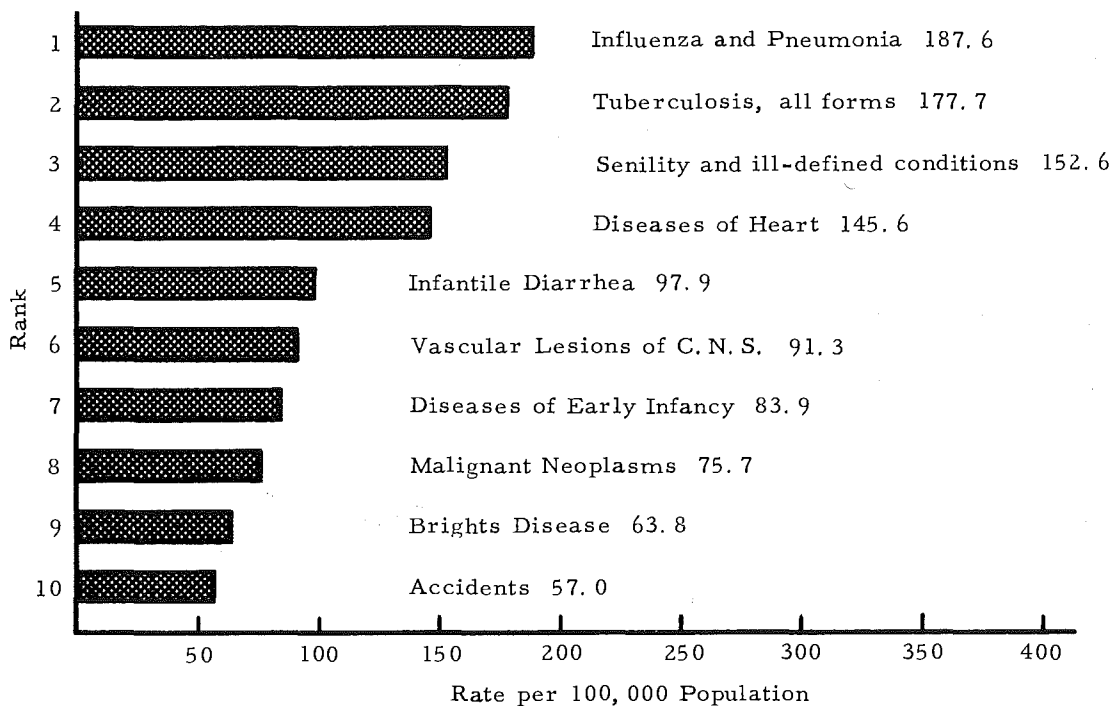

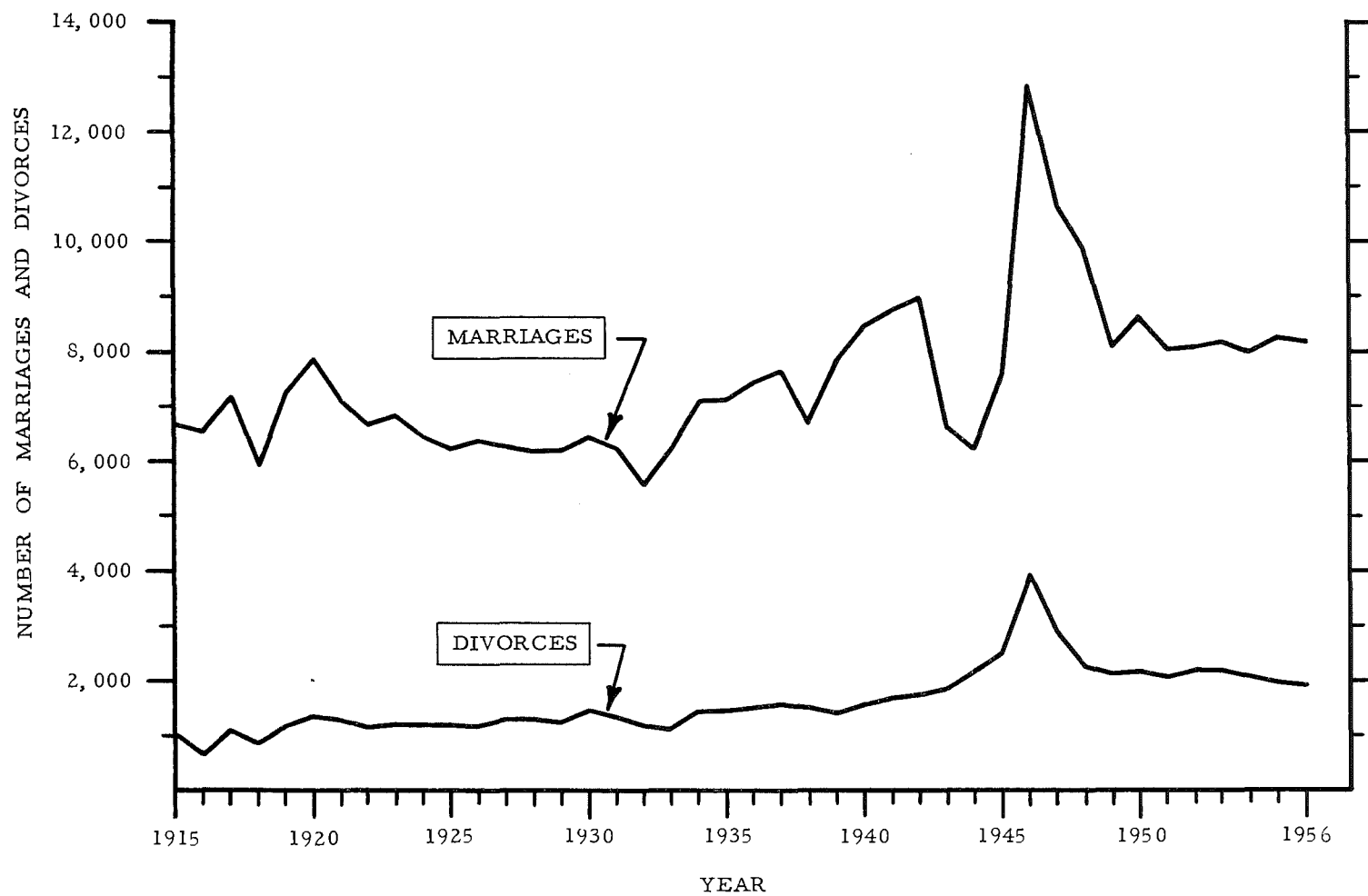
