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INTRODUCTION

This publication contains a summary of the vital statistics of the State of Maine during the year 1957. Births and deaths are tabulated for each county and for 48 selected cities and towns. The 48 cities and towns selected for separate tabulation are those places designated as urban in the 1950 Census of Population.

ALLOCATION OF VITAL EVENTS

Tabulations of births and deaths appearing in this report concern residents of Maine only, regardless of whether or not the birth or death actually occurred in Maine. Births are allocated to usual residence of the mother and deaths to the usual residence of the decedent. This information is obtained by the physician, undertaker, or other person responsible for filing the birth or death certificate.

The practice of allocating births and deaths to usual place of residence was initiated in 1935. This system of allocation is made possible by the exchange of transcripts of non-resident births and deaths with other states and with Canada.

Marriages and divorces are allocated to the place where the marriage was performed or where the divorce decree was granted rather than to the place of residence.

MORTALITY CLASSIFICATION

In 1948 the World Health Organization adopted the Sixth Revision of the International Lists of Diseases and Causes of Death for use in all participating countries. The Sixth Revision contains 612 categories of diseases and morbid conditions and 153 categories for the classification of the external cause of injury.

The Sixth Revision introduced an important change in the method for selecting the disease or morbid condition to which death is attributed for purposes of statistical tabulation. In earlier revisions, selections were made on the basis of a set of arbitrary rules. The Sixth Revision introduced a method whereby the physician in attendance at death indicates the disease or morbid condition which he considers to be the UNDERLYING cause of death. This is the condition to which death is attributed for purposes of statistical tabulation.

Use of the Sixth Revision has unquestionably resulted in more accurate mortality statistics than those obtained by use of older classification methods. However, in view of the important change in the method of selecting the cause of death, it is essential that persons making use of mortality statistics exercise extreme caution in analyzing long time trends in specific causes of deaths.

The following table shows provisional changes in the number of deaths attributed to selected causes which arose as the result of the change in the method classification. The change is expressed as the per cent increase or decrease in the number of deaths attributed to each selected condition upon the adoption of the Sixth Revision, and is based upon the 10 per cent national mortality sample.

Two abridged lists of cause of death are presented in this report. Deaths by selected age groups are tabulated in an abridged list of 254 causes and deaths by residence are tabulated in an abridged list of 65 causes.

POPULATION ESTIMATES

The estimate of the population of the State on July 1, 1957 which appears in this report is prepared by the U. S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census. Estimates of the population of Counties are prepared by the Division of Vital Statistics.

Estimates of the population of Counties which appear in this report are prepared by independently estimating the population of each county by means of a method combining vital rates and arithmetic progression. The estimates prepared in this manner are then adjusted by a constant factor so that the sum of the population of counties equals the population of the State as a whole.

RATES

Birth and crude mortality rates are expressed as the number of births or deaths per 1,000 population. Mortality rates attributed to specific diseases are expressed as the number of deaths per 100,000 population.

Infant mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 1,000 live births.

Maternal mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 10,000 live births.

Certain fluctuations may be expected in numbers and rates as a result of chance alone.

Generally speaking, these fluctuations will tend to be greater in cases where smaller populations are involved than when larger populations are involved.

FACTORS AFFECTING ACCURACY

A number of factors operate to produce certain slight inaccuracies in this report.

Some of the more important of these factors are outlined below:

(1) Completeness of registration: A birth registration test conducted in 1950 indicated that about 1.2 per cent of births in Maine are not recorded. In addition to unrecorded vital events, others may not be included in this report by reason of failure of the person required to report the event to make a timely report, or failure of a city or town clerk to make a timely report to the State Registrar, or failure of other states to make timely exchanges of non-resident transcripts of births and deaths.

(2) Errors in Data: Since the data from which this report is derived consists of copies of the original records of births, marriages, and deaths, two opportunities to introduce errors into the data are present. The person making the original record may make an erroneous entry on the record, or the person copying the record for the State Registrar may introduce errors in copying. Errors in either personal or medical information may be introduced in either way.

POPULATION

The population of Maine was estimated to be 939,000 on July 1, 1957. This represents a net gain in population of 25,000, or 2.8 per cent, over the number of inhabitants enumerated in the 1950 census. Total civilian population was estimated to be 923,000 on July 1, 1957. This represents a net gain of 1.2 per cent. The estimate of civilian population is based on 160,000 live births, 73,000 deaths, and an estimated net civilian migration of -66,000 between April 1, 1950 and July 1, 1957.

POPULATION OF COUNTIES

The following table shows the population of counties in Maine on July 1, 1957 with per cent changes in population between April 1, 1950 and July 1, 1957.

LIVE BIRTHS

There were 23,062 resident live births registered for Maine in 1957. This was 2.9 per cent more births than the number registered in 1956. The birth rate was 24.6 per 1,000 population.

SEX

The number of male live births was 11,793 and the number of female live births was 11,269. The sex ratio of live births was 104.6 male live births for every 100 female live births.

PLURAL BIRTHS

There were 239 plural births in which at least one child was born alive. Plural births included 236 twin births and 3 triplet births.

RACE

Less than 1 per cent of resident live births were non-white. The total number of non-white live births was 206. This represents an increase of nearly 40 per cent over the number of resident non-white live births in 1956.

The largest non-white group was the colored race with 106 live births. American Indian live births numbered 61, Japanese live births numbered 23, and persons of other non-white races gave birth to 16 live born children.

LEGITIMACY

There were 725 illegitimate live births to mothers who were Maine residents in 1957. Illegitimate live births represented 3.1 per cent of all resident live births.

HOSPITAL BIRTHS

The number of resident live births in hospitals and licensed maternity homes in 1957 was 22,601, or 98.0 per cent of all resident live births. This is an increase of 3.6 per cent in number over hospital births in 1956. The percentage of hospital births was 97.4 per cent in 1956.

FETAL DEATHS

Fetal deaths continued to decline in 1957. The number of resident fetal deaths was 538, or 6.8 per cent fewer than in 1956. The fetal death ratio was 23.3 fetal deaths per 1,000 live births as compared with a fetal death ratio of 25.8 in 1956. The decline in fetal deaths is due to a decline in the number of fetal deaths reported under 20 weeks gestation.

GESTATION


The following table shows resident fetal deaths in 1957 by length of gestation and the per cent change in each group from fetal deaths reported in 1956:

CAUSE OF FETAL DEATH

The following chart shows selected causes of fetal deaths for selected gestation periods during 1957:



GENERAL MORTALITY

There were 10,117 deaths among residents of Maine in 1957 and the crude mortality rate was 10.8 per 1,000 population. This was slightly less than the number of deaths in 1956 and the crude death rate was slightly lower.

SEX

The number of resident males dying was 5,668 and the number of females dying was 4,449. The estimated death rate among males was 12.2 per 1,000 male population and among females was 9.4 per 1,000 female population.

INFANT DEATHS

Infant deaths numbered 581 in 1957 and the infant mortality rate was 25.2 per 1,000 live births. This was slightly higher than the infant mortality rate in 1956 which was 25.0. 1957 marked the second successive year in which the infant mortality rate rose slightly in Maine.

Neonatal deaths (infant deaths during the first 4 weeks of life) numbered 431 and the neonatal mortality rate was 18.7 per 1,000 live births.

PERINATAL MORTALITY


The estimated perinatal mortality rate was 30.4 perinatal deaths per 1,000 live births and fetal deaths over 20 weeks gestation. This is slightly higher than the rate for 1956, which was 30.0.

The perinatal mortality rate is based on the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{Fetal deaths over 20 weeks} + \text{infant deaths under 7 days}}{\text{Total live births} + \text{fetal deaths over 20 weeks}} \times 1000$$

The 1957 perinatal mortality rate is based on an estimated 329 fetal deaths over 20 weeks gestation and 383 infant deaths during the first week of life.

The following chart shows the perinatal mortality rate and components for the years 1930 to 1957:



MATERNAL MORTALITY

There were 8 maternal deaths in Maine in 1957 and the maternal mortality rate was 3.5 per 10,000 live births. This was the lowest maternal mortality rate in the recorded history of the vital statistics of the State.

MARRIAGES

There were 7,878 marriages in Maine in 1957. This was 298 less than the number of marriages in 1956, and was the smallest number of marriages recorded in any year since 1945. The marriage rate was 8.4 per 1,000 population. This was the smallest marriage rate in any year since 1938.

PREVIOUS MARITAL STATUS

There were 5,739 marriages in which both the bride and groom were marrying for the first time. This was 221 less than the number of first marriages in 1956. The number of grooms marrying for the first time was 6,352 and the number of brides marrying for the first time was 6,304.

RESIDENCE OF PARTIES

The number of resident brides marrying in Maine was 7,337 and the number of resident grooms was 6,470. Residents of 46 states, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, and Canada, and several other foreign countries were married in Maine in 1957.

DIVORCES AND ANNULMENTS

There were 1,890 divorce decrees granted by the Superior Court in Maine in 1957. This was 1.5 per cent fewer than the number of divorces decreed in 1956, and marked the sixth successive year during which the number of divorces declined in Maine. The number of divorces granted in 1957 was the smallest number granted in any year since 1943.

The crude divorce rate was 2.0 divorces per 1,000 population. The divorce rate in Maine was lower in 1957 than in any year since 1940.

The number of marriages annulled in Maine in 1957 was 16.

SEX OF LIBELANT

In 1,436 or 75.9 per cent of the divorces decreed in 1957, the wife was the libelant.

CAUSE OF DIVORCE

Cruelty was the most frequent cause alleged on divorce libels. Cruelty was alleged as the cause of 1,645, or 87.0 per cent of all divorces decreed in Maine in 1957. The next most frequent cause alleged on the libel was desertion, which was alleged as the cause of 108, or 5.7 per cent of divorces decreed in Maine in 1957.

MINOR CHILDREN

The divorced couple had one or more minor children in 1,150 or 60.8 per cent of the divorces granted in Maine in 1957. The largest number of minor children involved in any divorce in 1957 was eight. In three divorces there were eight minor children.




MAINE, 1957


