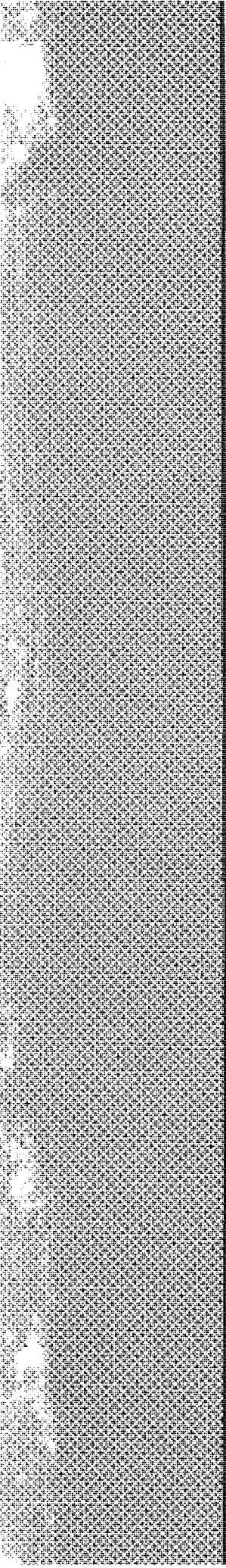

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INTRODUCTION

This report contains a summary of the Vital Statistics of the State of Maine for the calendar year 1959. Births and deaths are tabulated for each county and for 48 selected urban cities and towns. The 48 urban cities and towns selected for separate tabulation are those places designated as urban in the 1950 Census of Population.

ALLOCATION OF VITAL EVENTS

The Statistics on births and deaths in this report refer to residents of Maine only, regardless of whether or not the birth or death actually occurred in Maine. Statistics on marriages and divorces in this report have reference to non-residents as well as residents of Maine who marry in the State.

Births are allocated to the usual residence of the mother and deaths to the usual residence of the deceased. This information is obtained for the certificate by the physician, hospital record librarian, funeral director, or other person responsible for completing the certificate of birth or death. The practice of allocating births and deaths to usual place of residence was initiated in 1935. This system of allocation is made possible by the exchange of transcripts of non-resident births and deaths with other states and with Canada.

Marriages and divorces are allocated to the place in Maine where the marriage ceremony was performed or where the divorce decree was granted rather than to the place of residence.

FACTORS AFFECTING ACCURACY

A number of factors operate to produce certain slight inaccuracies in this report. Some of the more important of these factors are outlined below:

(1) Completeness of Registration: A birth certificate test conducted in 1950 indicated that about 1 per cent of births in Maine are not recorded. In addition to unrecorded vital events, others may not be included in this report by reason of failure of the person required to report the event to make a timely report, or failure of a city or town clerk to make a timely report to the State Registrar, or failure of other states to make timely exchanges of nonresident transcripts of births and deaths.

(2) Errors in Data: Data in this report is based upon original certificates of births and deaths, copies of original certificates of marriages prepared by city and town clerks, and abstracts of decrees of divorces prepared by clerks of courts. Errors in data may be introduced by persons giving information for the original certificate, persons involved in the actual preparation of the original certificate, or persons involved in the preparation of the copies or abstracts of the original certificates which are submitted to the State Registrar.

POPULATION ESTIMATES

The estimate of the population of the State on July 1, 1959 which appears in this report is prepared by the U. S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census. Estimates of the populations of counties are prepared by the Division of Vital Statistics.

The populations of counties are independent estimates prepared for each county by means of a method which combines the use of vital rates and arithmetic progression. The county population estimates prepared in this manner are then adjusted by a constant factor so that the sum of the population of counties equals the population of the State as a whole as estimated by the Bureau of the Census.

MORTALITY CLASSIFICATION

The International Conference for the 7th Revision of the International Lists of Diseases and Causes of Death, was held in Paris under the WHO auspices in 1955. The recommendations of this conference were adopted by the 9th World Health

Assembly in 1956, and the resulting new International Statistical Classification of Diseases, Injuries, and Causes of Death was placed in use in Maine and throughout most of the World on January 1, 1958.

The 7th Revision of the International Statistical Classification consists of a list of 612 categories of diseases and morbid conditions, plus 153 categories for classification of the external cause of injury, and 189 categories for the characterization of injuries according to the nature of the lesion.

Under the 7th Revision the method for selecting the cause of death for statistical purposes remained the same as the method under the 6th Revision. The 6th Revision, introduced in 1949, introduced a method whereby the physician in attendance at death indicates the disease or morbid condition which he considers to be the underlying cause of death. The underlying cause is defined as "(a) the disease or injury which initiated the train of events leading directly to death, or (b) the circumstances of the accident which produced fatal injury."

Two abridged lists of causes of death are presented in this report. Deaths by selected age groups are tabulated in an abridged list of 254 causes and deaths by residence are tabulated in an abridged list of 65 causes.

RATES

Birth rates and crude mortality rates are expressed as the number of births or deaths per 1,000 population. Mortality rates attributed to specific diseases are expressed as the number of deaths per 100,000 population.

Infant mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 1,000 live births. Maternal mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 10,000 live births.

Certain fluctuations may be expected in numbers and rates as the result of chance. Generally speaking, these fluctuations will tend to be greater in numbers and rates for areas with smaller populations than for areas with larger populations.

POPULATION

The population of Maine was estimated to be 958,000 on July 1, 1959. This represents a net gain in population of 44,000 or 4.8 per cent, over the number of inhabitants enumerated in the 1950 census. Total civilian population was estimated to be 941,000 on July 1, 1959. This represents a net gain of 30,000 in civilian population since 1950, or a gain of 3.3 per cent.

POPULATION OF COUNTIES

The following table shows the population of counties in Maine on July 1, 1959 with per cent changes in population between April 1, 1950 and July 1, 1959 as estimated by the State of Maine Department of Health and Welfare, Division of Vital Statistics.

LIVE BIRTHS

There were 23,141 resident live births registered for Maine in 1959. This was 0.06 per cent less births than the number registered in 1958. The birth rate was 24.2 per 1,000 population.

SEX

The number of male live births was 11,765 and the number of female live births was 11,376. The sex ratio of live births was 103.4 male live births for every 100 female live births.

PLURAL BIRTHS

There were 226 plural births in which at least one child was born alive. Plural births included 223 twin births and 3 triplet births.

RACE

Only about 1.1 per cent of all resident live births in 1959 were nonwhite. The total number of nonwhite births in 1959 were 256. This represents an increase of 16.4 per cent over the number of resident nonwhite live births in 1958.

The largest nonwhite group was Negroes, who gave birth to 129 live born children. American Indians gave birth to 60, Japanese gave birth to 19, and persons of other nonwhite races gave birth to 48 live born children in 1959.

LEGITIMACY

There were 766 illegitimate live births to mothers who were Maine residents in 1959. Illegitimate live births represented 3.3 per cent of all resident live births.

HOSPITAL BIRTHS

The number of resident live births in hospitals and licensed maternity homes in 1959 was 22,743, or 98.3 per cent of all resident live births. This is an increase of 0.1 per cent in number over hospital births in 1958. The percentage of hospital births was 98.1 per cent in 1958.

FETAL DEATHS

The number of resident fetal deaths was 443, or 5.3 per cent fewer than in 1958. The fetal death ratio was 19.1 fetal deaths per 1,000 live births as compared with a fetal death ratio of 20.2 in 1958.

GESTATION

The following table shows resident fetal deaths in 1959 by length of gestation and the per cent change in each group from fetal deaths reported in 1958.

GENERAL MORTALITY

There were 10,817 deaths among residents of Maine in 1959 and the crude mortality rate was 11.3 per 1,000 population. This was slightly more than the number of deaths in 1958 and the crude death rate was slightly higher.

SEX

The number of resident male deaths was 6,001 and the number of resident female deaths was 4,816. The estimated death rate among males was 12.7 per 1,000 male population and among females was 9.9 per 1,000 female population.

INFANT DEATHS

There were 612 infant deaths in Maine in 1959 and the infant mortality rate was 26.4 per 1,000 live births. This was slightly higher than the 1958 rate which was 26.3.

There were 442 neonatal deaths (infant deaths during the first 4 weeks of life) in 1959 and the neonatal mortality rate was 19.1 per 1,000 live births. This was a 8.9 and 9.1 per cent increase in number and rate over 1958.

PERINATAL MORTALITY

The estimated perinatal mortality rate in 1959 was 30.4 perinatal deaths per 1,000 live births and fetal deaths over 20 weeks gestation. This is slightly higher than the rate for 1958 which was 29.3.

The perinatal mortality rate is based on the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{Fetal deaths over 20 weeks} + \text{infant deaths under 7 days}}{\text{Total live births} + \text{fetal deaths over 20 weeks}} \times 1000$$

The 1959 perinatal mortality rate is based on an estimated 321 fetal deaths over 20 weeks gestation and 392 infant deaths during the first week of life.

MATERNAL MORTALITY

There were 6 maternal deaths in Maine in 1959 and the maternal mortality rate was 2.6 per 10,000 live births.

MARRIAGES

There were 7,599 marriages in Maine in 1959. This was 35 more than the number of marriages in 1958. The marriage rate was 7.9 per 1,000 population. This was the smallest marriage rate in any year since 1933.

PREVIOUS MARITAL STATUS

There were 4,457 marriages in Maine in 1959 in which both the bride and groom were marrying for the first time. This was 1,001 less than the number of first marriages in Maine in 1958. The number of grooms marrying for the first time in 1959 was 6,068 and the number of brides marrying for the first time in 1959 was 5,988.

RESIDENCE OF PARTIES

The number of resident brides marrying in 1959 was 7,074 and the number of resident grooms was 6,307. Residents of 45 of the 48 states, Alaska, Virgin Islands, Canada and several other foreign countries were married in Maine in 1959.

DIVORCES and ANNULMENTS

The Superior Court in Maine granted 1,960 divorces during the calendar year 1959. This was 4.6 per cent less than the number of divorces granted in 1958. The crude divorce rate was 2.0 per 1,000 population.

The number of marriages annulled by the Superior Court in Maine in 1959 was 17. This was the greatest number of annulments in the history of the State.

SEX OF LIBELANT

It was the wife who most frequently sought divorce. Divorces were granted to the wife in 1,530 or 78.1 per cent of all divorces granted in Maine in 1959.

LEGAL GROUNDS FOR DECREE

Cruelty was the legal grounds for decree in 89.5 per cent of divorces granted in Maine in 1959. Cruelty includes "cruel and abusive treatment" and "extreme cruelty."

DURATION OF MARRIAGE

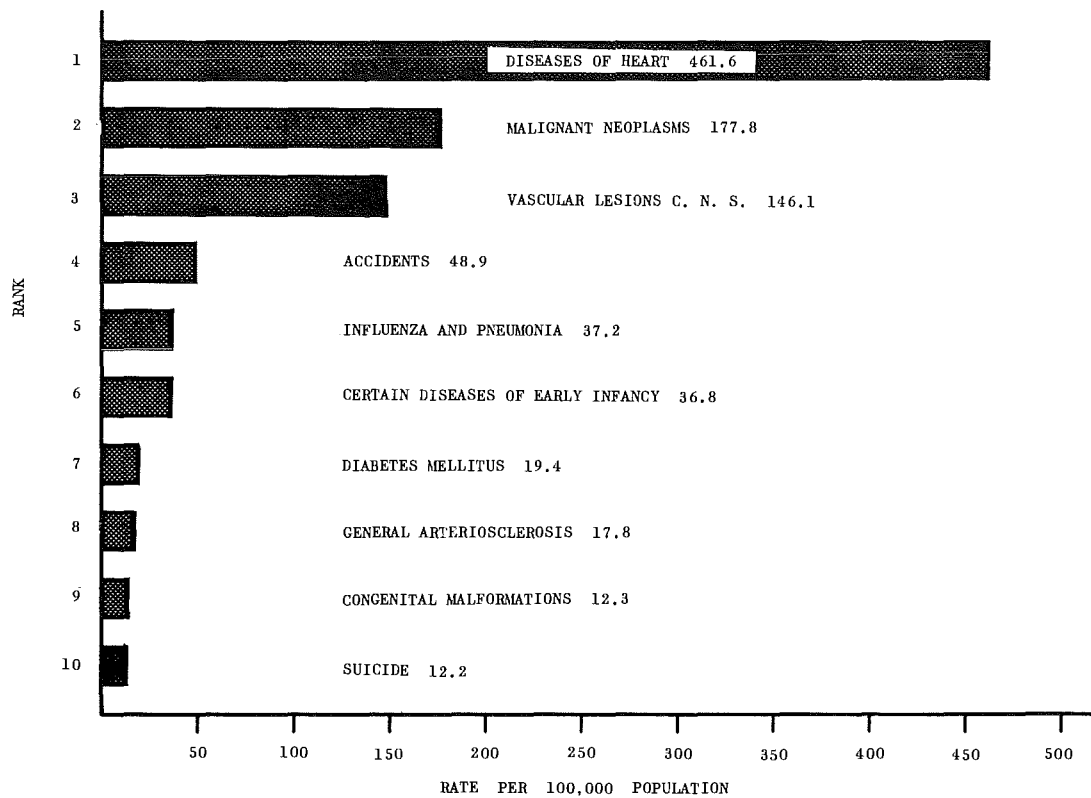
The median duration of marriage before divorce among 1959 divorces was 6 years. One half of the marriages ended by divorce in 1959 had lasted for 6 years or less and one half had lasted 7 years or more. The second year of marriage was the peak year during which marriages were ended by divorce.

MINOR CHILDREN

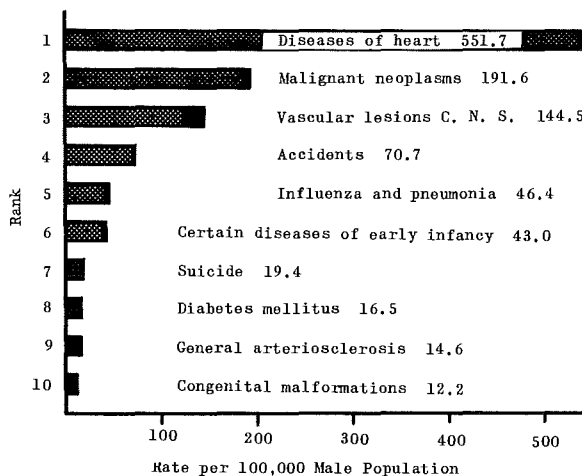
The divorced couple had one or more minor children in 1,225, or 62.5 per cent of 1959 divorces. One divorced couple had 12 minor children.

TEN LEADING CAUSES OF DEATH FEMALES, MAINE, 1959

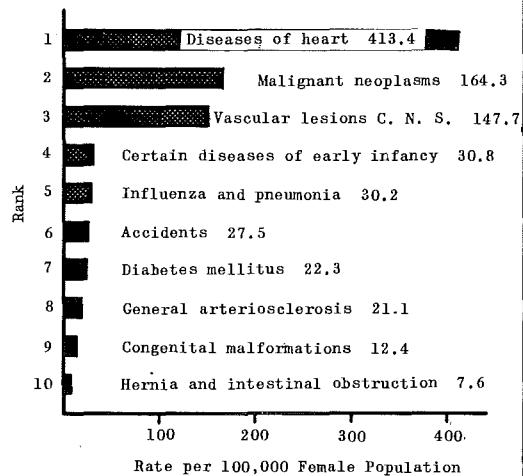
