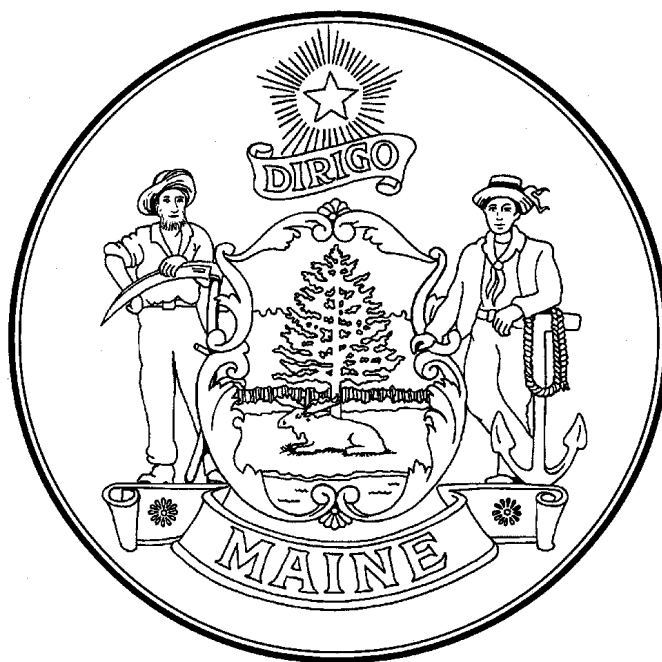

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INTRODUCTION

This report contains a summary of the Vital Statistics of the State of Maine for the calendar year 1963. Births and deaths are tabulated for each county and for 49 urban cities and towns. The 49 urban cities and towns selected for separate tabulation are those places designated as urban in the 1960 Census of Population.

ALLOCATION OF VITAL EVENTS

The statistics on births and deaths in this report refer to residents of Maine only, regardless of whether or not the birth or death actually occurred in Maine. Statistics on marriages and divorces in this report include nonresidents as well as residents of Maine who marry or are divorced in the State.

Births are allocated to the usual residence of the mother and deaths to the usual resident of the deceased. This information is obtained for the certificate by the physician, hospital record librarian, funeral director, or other person responsible for completing the certificate of birth or death. The practice of allocating births and deaths to usual place of residence was initiated in 1935. This method of allocation is made possible by the exchange of transcripts of nonresident births and deaths with other states and Canada.

Marriages and divorces are allocated to the place in Maine where the marriage ceremony was performed or where the divorce decree was granted, rather than the place of residence.

FACTORS AFFECTING ACCURACY

A number of factors operate to produce certain slight inaccuracies in this report. Some of the more important of these factors are outlined below:

- (1) Completeness of Registration: A birth certificate test conducted in 1950

indicated that about one percent of births in Maine are not recorded. In addition to unrecorded vital events, others may not be included in this report by reason of failure of the person required to report the event to make a timely report, or failure of a municipal clerk to make a timely report to the State Registrar, or failure of other states to make timely exchanges of nonresident transcripts of births and deaths.

(2) Errors in Data: Data in this report are based upon original certificates of births and deaths, copies of original certificates of marriages prepared by city and town clerks, and abstracts of decrees of divorces prepared by the clerks of courts. Errors in data may be introduced by persons giving information for the original certificate, persons involved in the actual preparation of the original certificate, or persons involved in the preparation of the copies or abstracts of the original certificates which are submitted to the State Registrar.

POPULATION ESTIMATES

The estimate of population of the State on July 1, 1963 which appears in the report is prepared by the U. S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Census. Estimates of the populations of the counties are prepared by the Division of Vital Statistics.

The population of counties are independent estimates prepared for each county. These estimates are computed by a method which assumes the population is directly proportional to the total number of vital events reported. The county population estimates prepared in this manner are then adjusted by a constant factor so that the sum of the population of all counties equals the population of the entire State as estimated by the Bureau of the Census.

MORTALITY CLASSIFICATION

The International Conference for the 7th Revision of the International Lists of Diseases and Causes of Death, was held in Paris under the WHO auspices in 1955. The recommendations of this conference were adopted by the 9th World Health Assembly in 1956, and the resulting new International Statistical Classification of Diseases,

Injuries, and Causes of Death was placed in use in Maine and throughout most of the World on January 1, 1958.

The 7th Revision of the International Statistical Classification consists of a list 612 categories of diseases and morbid conditions, plus 153 categories for classification of the external cause of injury, and 189 categories for the characterization of injuries according to the nature of lesion.

Under the 7th Revision the method for selecting the cause of death for statistical purposes remained the same as the method under the 6th Revision. The 6th Revision, introduced in 1949, instituted a method whereby the physician in attendance at death indicates the disease or morbid condition which he considers to be the underlying cause of death. The underlying cause is defined as "(a) the disease or injury which initiated the train of events leading directly to death, or (b) the circumstances of the accident which produced fatal injury."

Two abridged lists of causes of death are presented in this report. Deaths by selected age groups are tabulated in an abridged list of 254 causes and deaths by residence are tabulated in an abridged list of 65 causes.

RATES

Birth rates and crude mortality rates are expressed as the number of births or deaths per 1,000 population. Mortality rates attributed to specific diseases are expressed as the number of deaths per 100,000 population.

Infant mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 1,000 live births. Maternal mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 10,000 live births.

POPULATION

The population of Maine was estimated to be 982,000 on July 1, 1963. This represents a net gain in population of 13,000 or 1.3 percent, over the number of inhabitants enumerated in the 1960 census. Total civilian population was estimated to be 963,000 on July 1, 1963. This is a net gain of 13,000 in civilian population since April 1, 1960, or a gain of 1.4 percent.

LIVE BIRTHS

There were 21,919 resident live births registered for Maine in 1963. This was 4.7 percent fewer births than were registered in 1962. The birth rate was 22.3 per 1,000 population.

SEX

The number of male live births was 11,152 and the number of female live births was 10,767. The sex ratio of live births was 103.6 male live births for every 100 female live births.

PLURAL BIRTHS

There were 233 plural births in which at least one child was born alive. There were two sets of triplets and 231 twin births.

RACE

Only 1.4 percent of all resident live births in 1963 were nonwhite. The total number of nonwhite births in 1963 was 302. This represents an increase of 11.0 percent over the number of resident nonwhite births in 1962.

The largest nonwhite group was Negroes, who gave birth to 147 live born children. American Indians gave birth to 82, Japanese gave birth to 29, and persons of other nonwhite races gave birth to 44 live born children.

LEGITIMACY

There were 901 illegitimate live births to mothers who were Maine residents in 1963. Illegitimate live births represented 4.1 percent of all resident live births.

HOSPITAL BIRTHS

The number of resident live births in hospitals and licensed maternity homes in 1963 was 21,738 or 99.2 percent of all resident live births. This is a decrease of 4.7 in number of hospital births over 1962, but the percent of 99.2 is exactly the same as 1962.

FETAL DEATHS

The number of resident fetal deaths was 358, which was 8.9 percent less than in 1962. The fetal death ratio was 8.9 percent less than in 1962. The fetal death ratio was 16.3 per 1,000 live births as compared with a fetal death ratio of 17.11 in 1962.

The following table shows resident fetal deaths in 1963 by length of gestation and percent change in each group from fetal deaths reported in 1962.

GENERAL MORTALITY

There were 11,003 deaths of Maine residents in 1963 and the crude mortality rate was 11.2 per 1,000 population. This was slightly less than the number of deaths in 1962 and the crude death rate was slightly lower.

SEX

The number of resident male deaths was 6,153 and the number of resident female deaths was 4,850. The estimated death rate among males was 12.7 per 1,000 male population and among females was 9.8 per 1,000 female population.

INFANT DEATHS

There were 525 infant deaths in Maine during 1963 and the infant mortality rate was 24.0 per 1,000 live births. The 1962 rate was 25.3.

There were 393 neonatal deaths (infant deaths during the first four weeks of life) in 1963 and the neonatal mortality rate was 17.9 per 1,000 live births. This was a 6.0 and 0.2 percent decrease in number and rate over 1962.

PERINATAL MORTALITY

The estimated perinatal mortality rate in 1963 was 30.6 perinatal deaths per 1,000 live births and fetal deaths over 20 weeks gestation. This is slightly less than the 1962 rate of 32.0.

The perinatal mortality rate is based on the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{Fetal deaths over 20 weeks} + \text{infant deaths under 7 days}}{\text{Total live births} + \text{fetal deaths over 20 weeks}} \times 1,000$$

The 1963 perinatal mortality rate is based on an estimated 287 fetal deaths of 20 or more weeks of gestation and 393 neonatal deaths.

MATERNAL MORTALITY

There were 4 maternal deaths in Maine in 1963 and the maternal mortality rate was 1.8 per 10,000 live births.

MARRIAGES

There were 8,121 marriages in Maine in 1963. This was 141 more than the number of marriages in 1962. The marriage rate was 8.3 per 1,000 population.

PREVIOUS MARITAL STATUS

There were 5,767 marriages in Maine in 1963 in which both the bride and groom were marrying for the first time. This was 22 more than the number of first marriages in 1962. The number of grooms marrying for the first time was 6,375 and the number of brides marrying for the first time was 6,317.

RESIDENCE OF PARTIES

The number of resident brides marrying in 1963 was 7,567 and the number of resident grooms was 6,644. Residents of all of the 50 states except Alaska were married in Maine in 1963. Also residents of the Virgin Islands, Canada and several foreign countries were married in Maine.

DIVORCES and ANNULMENTS

The superior court in Maine granted 2,193 divorces during the calendar year 1963. This was 5.5 percent more than the number of divorces granted in 1962. The crude divorce rate was 2.2 per 1,000 population.

The number of marriages annulled by superior court in Maine in 1963 was 14.

SEX OF LIBELANT

It was the wife who most frequently sought divorce. Divorces were granted to the wife in 1,713 or 78.1 percent of all divorces granted in Maine in 1963.

LEGAL GROUNDS FOR DECREE

Cruelty was the legal grounds for decree in 93.8 percent of divorces granted in Maine in 1963. Cruelty includes "cruel and abusive treatment" and "extreme cruelty."

DURATION OF MARRIAGE

The median duration of marriage before divorce among 1963 divorces was 5.8 years. The first year of marriage was the peak year during which marriages were ended by divorce.

MINOR CHILDREN

The divorced couple had one or more minor children in 1,473 or 67.2 percent of 1963 divorces. Two divorced couples had 10 minor children.

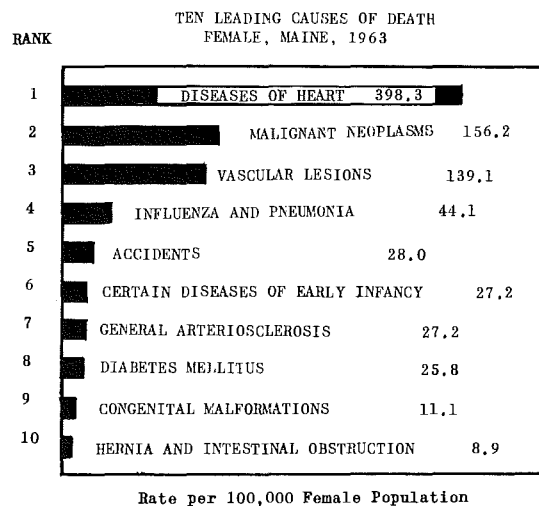
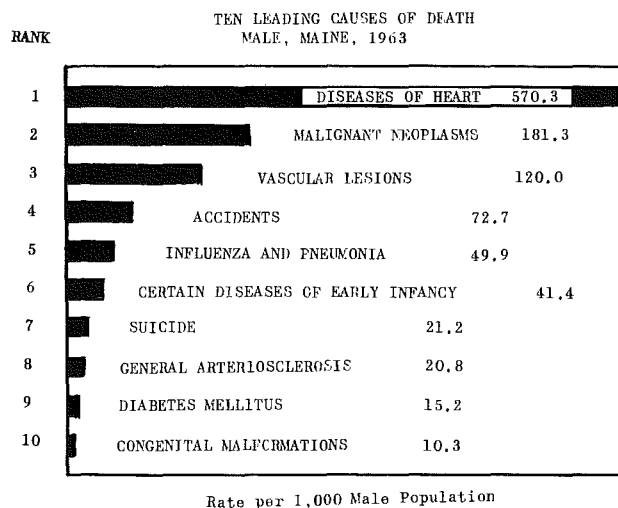
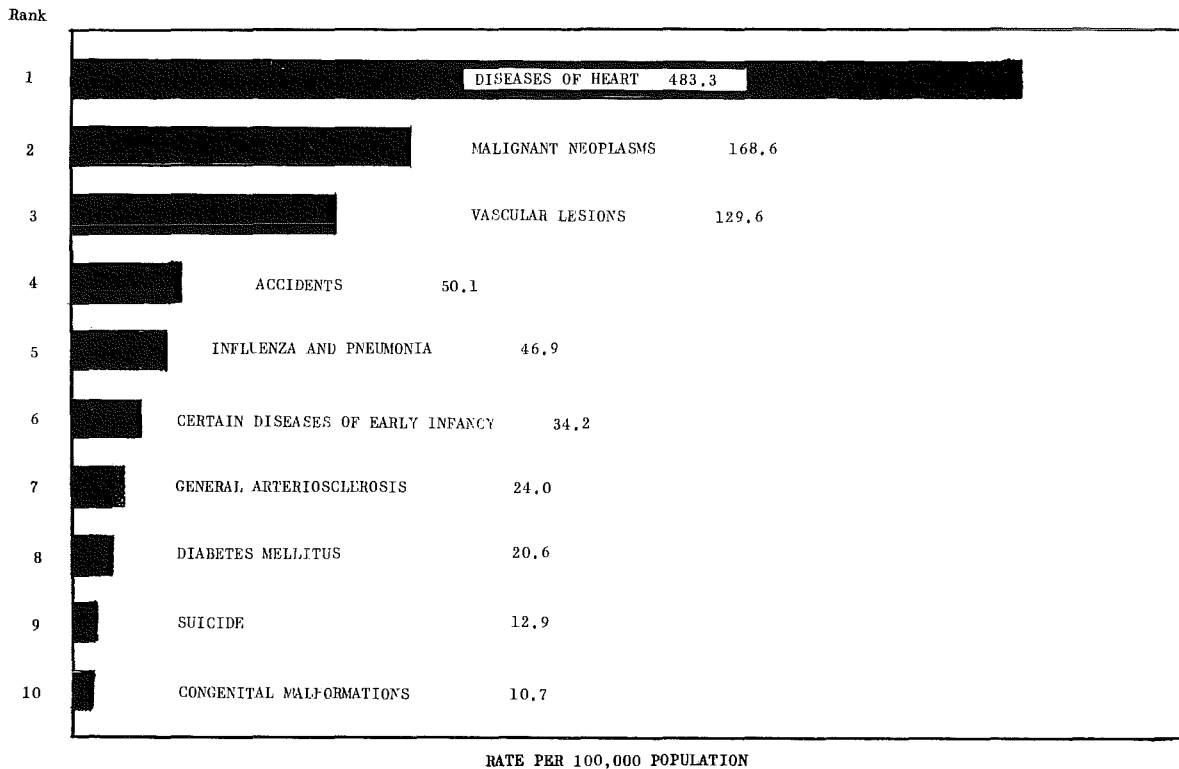
