INTRODUCTION

This report contains a summary of the Vital Statistics of the State of Maine for the calendar year 1966. Births and deaths are tabulated for each county and for 49 urban cities and towns. The 49 urban cities and towns selected for separate tabulation are those places designated as urban in the 1960 Census of Population.

ALLOCATION OF VITAL EVENTS

The statistics on births and deaths in this report refer to residents of Maine only, regardless of whether or not the birth or death actually occurred in Maine. Statistics on marriages and divorces in this report include nonresidents as well as residents of Maine who marry or are divorced in the State.

Births are allocated to the usual residence of the mother and deaths to the usual resident of the deceased. This information is obtained for the certificate by the physician, hospital record librarian, funeral director, or other person responsible for completing the certificate of birth or death. The practice of allocating births and deaths to usual place of residence was initiated in 1935. This method of allocation is made possible by the exchange of transcripts of nonresident births and deaths with other states and Canada.

Marriages and divorces are allocated to the place in Maine where the marriage ceremony was performed or where the divorce decree was granted, rather than the place of residence.

FACTORS AFFECTING ACCURACY

A number of factors operate to produce certain slight inaccuracies in this report. Some of the more important of these factors are outlined below:

- (1) Completeness of Registration: A birth certificate test conducted in 1950

indicated that about one per cent of births in Maine are not recorded. In addition to unrecorded vital events, others may not be included in this report by reason of failure of the person required to report the event to make a timely report, or failure of a municipal clerk to make a timely report to the State Registrar, or failure of other states to make timely exchanges of nonresident transcripts of births and deaths.

(2) Errors in Data: Data in this report are based upon original certificates of births and deaths, copies of original certificates of marriages prepared by city and town clerks, and abstracts of decrees of divorces prepared by the clerks of courts. Errors in data may be introduced by persons giving information for the original certificate, persons involved in the actual preparation of the original certificate, or persons involved in the preparation of the copies or abstracts of the original certificates which are submitted to the State Registrar.

POPULATION ESTIMATES

The estimate of population of the State on July 1, 1966 which appears in the report is prepared by the U. S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Census. Estimates of the populations of the counties are prepared by the Division of Vital Statistics.

The population of counties are independent estimates prepared for each county. These estimates are computed by a method which assumes the population is directly proportional to the total number of vital events reported. The county population estimates prepared in this manner are then adjusted by a constant factor so that the sum of the population of all counties equals the population of the entire State as estimated by the Bureau of the Census.

MORTALITY CLASSIFICATION

The International Conference for the 7th Revision of the International Lists of Diseases and Causes of Death, was held in Paris under the WHO auspices in 1955. The recommendations of this conference were adopted by the 9th World Health Assembly in 1956, and the resulting new International Statistical Classification of Diseases,

Injuries, and Causes of Death was placed in use in Maine and throughout most of the World on January 1, 1958.

The 7th Revision of the International Statistical Classification consists of a list of 612 categories of diseases and morbid conditions, plus 153 categories for classification of the external cause of injury, and 189 categories for the characterization of injuries according to the nature of lesion.

Under the 7th Revision the method for selecting the cause of death for statistical purposes remained the same as the method under the 6th Revision. The 6th Revision, introduced in 1949, instituted a method whereby the physician in attendance at death indicates the disease or morbid condition which he considers to be the underlying cause of death. The underlying cause is defined as "(a) the disease or injury which initiated the train of events leading directly to death, or (b) the circumstances of the accident which produced fatal injury."

Two abridged lists of causes of death are presented in this report. Deaths by selected age groups are tabulated in an abridged list of 254 causes and deaths by residence are tabulated in an abridged list of 65 causes.

RATES

Birth rates and crude mortality rates are expressed as the number of births or deaths per 1,000 population. Mortality rates attributed to specific diseases are expressed as the number of deaths per 100,000 population.

Infant mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 1,000 live births. Maternal mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 10,000 live births.

POPULATION

The population of Maine was estimated to be 986,567 on July 1, 1966. This represents a net gain in population of 17,302 or 1.8 per cent, over the number of inhabitants enumerated in the 1960 census. Total civilian population was estimated to be 977,251 on July 1, 1966. This represents a net gain of 25,053 or 2.6 per cent in civilian population since April 1, 1960. The natural increase in total population between April 1, 1960 and July 1, 1966 was 68,760 and the estimated net outward migration was 51,458.

LIVE BIRTHS

There were 18,526 resident live births registered in Maine in 1966. This was 6.4 per cent fewer births than were registered in 1965, and marks the fifth successive year that the birth rate has decreased. The birth rate was 18.8 per 1,000 population. This is the lowest yearly birth rate since 1941.

SEX

The number of male live births was 9,339 and the number of female live births was 9,187. The sex ratio of live births was 101.7 male live births for every 100.0 female live births.

PLURAL BIRTHS

There were 171 plural births in which at least one child was born alive. 1966 plural births consisted of 170 twin births and 1 triplet birth.

RACE

Only 1.2 per cent of all resident live births in 1966 were nonwhite. The total number of nonwhite births in 1966 was 214. This is a decrease of 13.7 per cent less than the number of resident nonwhite live births in 1965.

The largest nonwhite group was Negroes, who gave birth to 102 live born children. American Indians gave birth to 71, Japanese gave birth to 11, and persons of other non-white races gave birth to 30 live born children.

LEGITIMACY

There were 1,047 illegitimate births to mothers who were Maine residents in 1966. Illegitimate live births represented 5.7 per cent of all resident live births. This marks the seventh successive year that the percentage of illegitimate live births has increased.

HOSPITAL BIRTHS

The number of resident live births in hospitals and licensed maternity homes in 1966 was 18,457 or 99.6 per cent of all resident live births.

FETAL DEATHS

The number of resident fetal deaths was 278, which was 19.7 per cent less than 1965. The fetal death rate was 15.0 per 1,000 live births in 1966. This was the lowest fetal death rate in the history of the State.

GESTATION

The following table shows resident fetal deaths in 1966 by length of gestation and per cent change in each group from fetal deaths reported in 1965.

GENERAL MORTALITY

There were 10,915 deaths of Maine residents in 1966 and the crude mortality rate was 11.1. This is a 1.3 and 1.8 per cent increase in number and rate respectively over 1965.

SEX

The number of resident male deaths was 6,024 and the number of female deaths was 4,891. The estimated death rate among males was 12.4 per 1,000 male population and among females was 9.5 per 1,000 female population.

INFANT DEATHS

There were 418 infant deaths in Maine during 1966 and the infant mortality rate was 22.6. The infant mortality rate has decreased 10.3 per cent since 1960, 27.6 per cent since 1950, 57.3 per cent since 1940 and 70.0 per cent since 1930.

There were 317 neonatal deaths (infant deaths during the first 4 weeks of life) in 1966 and the neonatal mortality rate was 17.1 per 1,000 live births. The neonatal mortality rate has decreased 7.5 per cent since 1960, 21.8 per cent since 1950, 49.4 per cent since 1940, and 58.6 per cent since 1930.

PERINATAL MORTALITY

The estimated perinatal mortality rate in 1966 was 29.9 perinatal deaths per 1,000 live births and fetal deaths of 20 weeks or more gestation.

The perinatal mortality rate is based on the following formula:

Fetal deaths 20 weeks or more + neonatal deaths

$$\frac{\text{Fetal deaths 20 weeks or more} + \text{neonatal deaths}}{\text{Total live births} + \text{fetal deaths 20 weeks or more}} \times 1000$$

The 1966 perinatal mortality rate is based on an estimated 245 fetal deaths of 20 or more weeks gestation and 317 neonatal deaths.

MATERNAL MORTALITY

There were no maternal deaths in Maine in 1966. This was the first year in the history of the State that there have been no maternal deaths.

MARRIAGES

There were 8,983 marriages in Maine in 1966. This was 257 more than in 1965 and marks the seventh successive year that the number of marriages has increased. The marriage rate was 9.1 per 1,000 population. The marriage rate has increased 11.1 per cent since 1960, but is 4.3 per cent less than the 1950 marriage rate. 1966 marks the fifth successive year that the marriage rate has increased.

PREVIOUS MARITAL STATUS

There were 6,273 marriages in Maine in 1966 in which both the bride and groom were marrying for the first time. This was 79 more than the number of first marriages in 1965. 77.9 per cent of the grooms and 76.7 per cent of the brides were married for the first time.

RESIDENCE OF PARTIES

The number of resident brides marrying in 1966 was 8,398 and the number of resident grooms was 7,424. Residents of all the states, the Virgin Islands, Canada and several other foreign countries were married in Maine in 1966.

DIVORCES and ANNULMENTS

There were 2,630 divorces granted in Maine during the calendar year 1966. This was 5.1 per cent more than the number of divorces granted in 1965. The crude divorce rate was 2.7 per 1,000 population. 1966 marks the fifth successive year that the divorce rate has increased. The number of marriages annulled in 1966 was 24.

SEX OF LIBELANT

It was the wife who most frequently sought divorce. Divorces were granted to the wife in 2,085 or 79.3 per cent of all divorcees granted in 1966.

LEGAL GROUNDS FOR DECREE

Cruelty was the legal grounds for decree in 97.1 per cent of divorces granted in Maine in 1966. Cruelty includes "cruel and abusive treatment" and "extreme cruelty."

DURATION OF MARRIAGE

The median duration of marriage before divorce was 6.1 years. The first year of marriage was the peak year during which marriages were ended by divorce.

MINOR CHILDREN

The divorced couple had one or more minor children in 1,819 or 69.2 per cent of 1966 divorces. One divorced couple had 12 minor children.

LEADING CAUSES of DEATH

In the following table, "Life Lost" is based on expectation of life from the 1965 United States life tables. The death of an infant represents a total of 70.2 years "life lost".

When one examines the leading causes of death in terms of "Life Lost" rather than total deaths, an entirely different picture is presented. "Certain diseases of early infancy" which caused only 2.4 per cent of total deaths, caused 10.0 per cent of the total "life lost" in 1966 and jumped from sixth place in total deaths to third place in total "life lost". Congenital malformations jumped from 12th place in total deaths to 7th place in "Life Lost". Accidents caused only 4.6 per cent of total deaths but 9.9 per cent of total "life lost". Diseases of the heart caused 42.8 per cent of total deaths but only 33.5 per cent of total life lost.

Years of life lost per 1,000 population and per cent of total life lost for 1965 is presented in table 3 because this data in the 1965 annual report was computed differently. No "life lost" was allowed for a person dying beyond 70.2 years of age.

The largest increases in total "life lost" between 1965 and 1966 were Pulmonary emphysema which increased 43.2 per cent, and cirrhosis of the liver which increased 23.4 per cent. The largest decrease in total "life lost" was certain diseases of early infancy which decreased 6.1 per cent.
