## INTRODUCTION

---

This report contains a summary of the Vital Statistics of the State of Maine for the calendar year 1967. Births and deaths are tabulated for each county and for 49 urban cities and towns. The 49 urban cities and towns selected for separate tabulation are those places designated as urban in the 1960 Census of Population.

### ALLOCATION OF VITAL EVENTS

The statistics on births and deaths in this report refer to residents of Maine only, regardless of whether or not the birth or death actually occurred in Maine. Statistics on marriages and divorces in this report include nonresidents as well as residents of Maine who marry or are divorced in the State.

Births are allocated to the usual residence of the mother and deaths to the usual residence of the deceased. This information is obtained for the certificate by the physician, hospital record librarian, funeral director, or other person responsible for completing the certificate of birth or death. The practice of allocating births and deaths to usual place of residence was initiated in 1935. This method of allocation is made possible by the exchange of transcripts of nonresident births and deaths with other states and Canada.

Marriages and divorces are allocated to the place in Maine where the marriage ceremony was performed or where the divorce decree was granted, rather than the place of residence.

### FACTORS AFFECTING ACCURACY

A number of factors operate to produce certain slight inaccuracies in this report. Some of the more important of these factors are outlined below:

- (1) Completeness of Registration: A birth certificate test conducted in 1950

indicated that about one per cent of births in Maine are not recorded. In addition to unrecorded vital events, others may not be included in this report by reason of failure of the person required to report the event to make a timely report, or failure of a municipal clerk to make a timely report to the State Registrar, or failure of other states to make timely exchanges of nonresident transcripts of births and deaths.

(2) Errors in Data: Data in this report are based upon original certificates of births and deaths, copies of original certificates of marriages prepared by city and town clerks, and abstracts of decrees of divorces prepared by the clerks of courts. Errors in data may be introduced by persons giving information for the original certificate, persons involved in the actual preparation of the original certificate, or persons involved in the preparation of the copies or abstracts of the original certificates which are submitted to the State Registrar.

#### POPULATION ESTIMATES

The estimate of county population of the state on July 1, 1967 which appears in this report is prepared by the Division of Research and Vital Records of the Maine State Department of Health and Welfare. These estimates are computed by a component method in which a multiple regression analysis is used to estimate the net migration rate. The variables used in the regression analysis are births, deaths, school enrollment and group quarter population. The final estimate is obtained by adding to the 1960 population count the births, subtracting the deaths and then adding the estimated net migration. The estimated state total is merely the summation of the 16 county estimates.

#### MORTALITY CLASSIFICATION

The International Conference for the 7th Revision of the International Lists of Diseases and Causes of Death, was held in Paris under the WHO auspices in 1955. The recommendations of this conference were adopted by the 9th World Health Assembly in 1956, and the resulting new International Statistical Classification of Diseases,

Injuries, and Causes of Death was placed in use in Maine and throughout most of the World on January 1, 1958.

The 7th Revision of the International Statistical Classification consists of a list of 612 categories of diseases and morbid conditions, plus 153 categories for classification of the external cause of injury, and 189 categories for the characterization of injuries according to the nature of lesion.

Under the 7th Revision the method for selecting the cause of death for statistical purposes remained the same as the method under the 6th Revision. The 6th Revision, introduced in 1949, instituted a method whereby the physician in attendance at death indicates the disease or morbid condition which he considers to be the underlying cause of death. The underlying cause is defined as "(a) the disease or injury which initiated the train of events leading directly to death, or (b) the circumstances of the accident which produced fatal injury."

Two abridged lists of causes of death are presented in this report. Deaths by selected age groups are tabulated in an abridged list of 254 causes and deaths by residence are tabulated in an abridged list of 65 causes.

#### RATES

Birth rates and crude mortality rates are expressed as the number of births or deaths per 1,000 population. Mortality rates attributed to specific diseases are expressed as the number of deaths per 100,000 population.

Infant mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 1,000 live births. Maternal mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 10,000 live births.

# POPULATION

The population of Maine was estimated to be 987,717 on July 1, 1967. This represents a net gain in population of 18,452, or 1.9 per cent, over the number of inhabitants enumerated in the 1960 census, and a gain of 1,150, or 1.2 per cent over the estimated population of 1966. The natural increase in total population between April 1, 1960 and July 1, 1967 was 75,442 and the estimated net outward migration was 56,990.

## LIVE BIRTHS

There were 17,976 resident live births registered in Maine in 1967. This was 3.0 per cent fewer births than were registered in 1966, and marks the sixth successive year that the birth rate has decreased. The birth rate for 1967 was 18.2 per 1,000 population. This is the lowest yearly birth rate since 1940.

### SEX

The number of male live births was 9,151 and the number of female live births was 8,825. The sex ratio of live births was 103.7 male live births for every 100.0 female live births.

### PLURAL BIRTHS

There were 179 plural births in which at least one child was born alive. 1967 plural births consisted of 177 twin births and 2 triplet births.

### RACE

Only 1.2 per cent of all resident live births in 1967 were nonwhite. The total number of nonwhite births in 1967 was 212. This is a decrease of only 0.9 per cent less than the number of resident nonwhite live births in 1966.

The largest nonwhite group was Negroes, who gave birth to 92 live born children. American Indians gave birth to 65, Japanese gave birth to 12, and persons of other nonwhite races gave birth to 43 live born children.

### LEGITIMACY

There were 1,129 illegitimate births to mothers who were Maine residents in 1967. Illegitimate live births represented 6.3 per cent of all resident live births. This marks the eighth successive year that the percentage of illegitimate live births has increased.

### HOSPITAL BIRTHS

The number of resident live births in hospitals and licensed maternity homes in 1967 was 17,896 or 99.6 per cent of all resident live births.

## FETAL DEATHS

The number of resident fetal deaths in 1967 was 290, which was 4.3 per cent more than the number in 1966. The fetal death rate was 16.1 per 1,000 live births. This is an increase over the previous year by 1.1 fetal deaths per 1,000 live births, yet still lower than any year prior to 1966.

### GESTATION

The following table shows resident fetal deaths in 1967 by length of gestation and per cent change in each group from fetal deaths reported in 1966.

## GENERAL MORTALITY

There were 11,066 deaths of Maine residents in 1967 and the crude mortality rate was 11.2. This is a 1.4 and 0.9 per cent increase in number and rate respectively over 1966.

### SEX

In 1967 the number of resident male deaths was 6,165 and the number of resident female deaths was 4,901. The estimated death rate among males was 12.6 per 1,000 male population and among females was 9.8 per 1,000 female population.

### INFANT DEATHS

There were 416 infant deaths in Maine during 1967 and the infant mortality rate was 23.1. This was a 0.5 per cent decrease and 2.2 per cent increase in number and rate respectively over 1966. The infant mortality rate has decreased 8.3 per cent since 1960, 26.0 per cent since 1950, 56.3 per cent since 1940, and 69.4 per cent since 1930.

There were 295 neonatal deaths (infant deaths during the first four weeks of life) in 1967 and the neonatal mortality rate was 16.4 per 1,000 live births. This was the lowest neonatal mortality rate in the history of the State.

## PERINATAL MORTALITY

The estimated perinatal mortality rate in 1967 was 29.9 perinatal deaths per 1,000 live births and fetal deaths of twenty weeks or more gestation.

The perinatal mortality rate is based on the following formula:

Fetal deaths 20 weeks or more + neonatal deaths

\_\_\_\_\_ X 1000

Total live births + fetal deaths 20 weeks or more

The 1967 perinatal mortality rate is based on an estimated 250 fetal deaths of 20 or more weeks gestation and 295 neonatal deaths.

## MATERNAL MORTALITY

There were no maternal deaths in Maine in 1967. This marks the second successive year that there have been no maternal deaths in the State, with the previous year having been the first year in the history of the State that there were no maternal deaths.

## MARRIAGES

There were 9,210 marriages in Maine in 1967. This was 227 more than in 1966 and marks the eighth successive year that the number of marriages has increased. The marriage rate was 9.3 per 1,000 population. The marriage rate has increased 14.8 per cent since 1960, but is 1.1 per cent less than the 1950 marriage rate. 1967 marks the sixth successive year that the marriage rate has increased.

### PREVIOUS MARITAL STATUS

There were 6,419 marriages in Maine in 1967 in which both the bride and groom were marrying for the first time. This was 146 more than the number of first marriages in 1966. 76.8 per cent of the grooms and 77.1 per cent of the brides were married for the first time.

### RESIDENCE OF PARTIES

The number of resident brides marrying in 1967 was 8,629, and the number of resident grooms was 7,651. Residents of all the states, Canada, and several other foreign countries were married in Maine in 1967.

## DIVORCES and ANNULMENTS

There were 3,049 divorces granted in Maine in 1967. This was 15.9 per cent more than the number of divorces granted in 1966. The crude divorce rate was 3.1 per 1,000 population. 1967 marks the sixth successive year that the divorce rate has increased.

The number of marriages annulled in 1967 was 12.

### SEX OF PLAINTIFF AND LIBELANT

The wife sought divorce in 2,304, or 75.6 per cent, of all the divorces granted in 1967, yet was granted the divorce in 2,442, or 80.1 per cent of all the divorces granted.

### LEGAL GROUNDS FOR DECREE

Cruelty was the legal grounds for decree in 97.0 per cent of all divorces granted in Maine in 1967. Cruelty includes "cruel and abusive treatment" and extreme cruelty".

#### DURATION OF MARRIAGE

The median duration of marriage before divorce among 1967 divorces was 6.8 years. The second year of marriage was the peak year during which marriages were ended by divorce.

#### MINOR CHILDREN

The divorced couple had one or more minor children in 2,096 or 68.7 per cent of 1967 divorces. One divorced couple had 11 minor children.

In the following table, "Life Lost" is based on the expectation of life from the 1967 United States Life Tables. In 1967 the death of an infant represented a total of 70.8 years of "Life Lost" and the death of a person 85 years of age represented 4.9 years of "Life Lost".

Causes worth examining for comparison of "Life Lost" and total deaths are diseases of the heart, accidents, and certain diseases of early infancy. Diseases of the heart were responsible for 41.7 per cent of all 1967 deaths but only 29.8 per cent of the total years of "Life Lost". Also significant is the fact that the per cent of total "Life Lost" in accidents was more than twice the per cent of total deaths caused by accidents, and the per cent of total "Life Lost" due to certain diseases of early infancy was over four times as large as the per cent of total deaths caused by certain diseases of early infancy. Other points worth notice are that although General arteriosclerosis is 6th ranked as a cause by total deaths it is 12th by total years of "Life Lost". Also, congenital malformations, which are 12th ranked by total deaths are 6th ranked by "Life Lost".

The largest increase in total "Life Lost" between 1966 and 1967 was in accidents, which were responsible for 14.1 per cent more "Life Lost". The largest decreases were in general arteriosclerosis which decreased 28.6 per cent, influenza and pneumonia which decreased 28.0 per cent, and diseases of the heart which decreased 17.8 per cent.
