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INTRODUCTION

This report contains a summary of the Vital Statistics of the State of Maine for the calendar year 1969. Births are tabulated for each county and all minor civil divisions and deaths are tabulated for each county and 45 selected minor civil divisions.

ALLOCATION OF VITAL EVENTS

The statistics on births and deaths in this report refer to residents of Maine only, regardless of whether or not the birth or death actually occurred in Maine. Statistics on marriages and divorces in this report include non-residents as well as residents of Maine who marry or are divorced in the State.

Births are allocated to the usual residence of the mother and deaths to the usual resident of the deceased. This information is obtained for the certificate by the physician, hospital record librarian, funeral director, or other person responsible for completing the certificate of birth or death. The practice of allocating births and deaths to usual place of residence was initiated in 1935. This method of allocation is made possible by the exchange of transcripts of nonresident births and deaths with other states and Canada.

Marriages and divorces are allocated to the place in Maine where the marriage ceremony was performed or where the divorce decree was granted, rather than the place of residence.

FACTORS AFFECTING ACCURACY

A number of factors operate to produce certain slight inaccuracies in this report.

Some of the more important of these factors are outlined below:

(1) Completeness of Registration: A birth certificate test conducted in 1950 indicated that about one percent of births in Maine are not recorded. In addition to unrecorded vital events, others may not be included in this report by reason of failure of the person required to report the event to make a timely report, or failure of a municipal clerk to make a timely report to the State Registrar, or failure of other states to make timely exchanges of nonresident transcripts of births and deaths.

(2) Errors in Data: Data in this report are based upon original certificates of births and deaths, copies of original certificates of marriages prepared by city and town clerks, and abstracts of decrees of divorces prepared by the clerks of courts. Errors in data may be introduced by persons giving information for the original certificate, persons involved in the actual preparation of the original certificate, or persons involved in the preparation of the copies or abstracts of the original certificates which are submitted to the State Registrar.

POPULATION ESTIMATES

The estimate of County populations on July 1, 1969 which appears in this report is prepared by the State of Maine Division of Research and Vital Records.

These County estimates are prepared by a post intercensal method which assumes that the annual net migration is linearly distributed throughout the decade. The population of a County is equal to the 1960 population plus the births, minus the deaths, plus the net migration. The State total is merely the summation of the Counties.

MORTALITY CLASSIFICATION

The mortality classification used in this report is the 8th Revision of the International Statistical Classification consisting of a list of 671 categories of diseases and morbid conditions, plus 182 categories for classification of the external cause of injury, and 187 categories for the characterization of injuries according to the nature of lesion.

Under the 8th Revision the method for selecting the cause of death for statistical purposes remained the same as the method under the 6th Revision. The 6th Revision, introduced in 1949, instituted a method whereby the physician in attendance at death indicates the disease or morbid condition which he considers to be the underlying cause of death. The underlying cause is defined as "(a) the disease or injury which initiated the train of events leading directly to death, or (b) the circumstances of the accident which produced fatal injury."

Two abridged lists of causes of death are presented in this report. Deaths by selected age groups are tabulated in an abridged list of 282 causes and deaths by residence are tabulated in an abridged list of 69 causes.

RATES

Birth rates and crude mortality rates are expressed as the number of births or deaths per 1,000 population. Mortality rates attributed to specific diseases are expressed as the number of deaths per 100,000 population.

Infant mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 1,000 live births. Maternal mortality rates are expressed as the number of deaths per 10,000 live births.

POPULATION

The population of Maine was estimated to be 993,907 on July 1, 1969. This represents a net gain in population of 24,642 or 2.5 percent over the number of inhabitants enumerated in the 1960 census. Total civilian population was estimated to be 981,545 on July 1, 1969. This represents a net gain of 31,315 or 3.3 percent in civilian population since April 1, 1960. The natural increase in total population between April 1, 1960 and July 1, 1969 was 87,881 and the estimated net outward migration was 63,239.

LIVE BIRTHS

There were 17,364 resident live births registered in Maine in 1969. This is 3.0 percent more births than were registered in 1968, and marks the first year that the birth rate has increased since 1961. The birth rate was 17.5 per 1,000 population. This is a higher rate than in 1968 but lower than in any previous year.

SEX

The number of male live births was 8,895 and the number of female live births was 8,469. The sex ratio of live births was 105.0 male live births for every 100.0 female live births.

PLURAL BIRTHS

In 1969, there were 335 children born alive in plural births.

RACE

Only 1.2 percent of all resident live births in 1969 were nonwhite. The total number of nonwhite births in 1969 was 210. This is a decrease of 5.2 percent of the number of resident nonwhite live births in 1968.

The largest nonwhite group was American Indians, who gave birth to 73 live born children. Negroes gave birth to 64, Japanese gave birth to 8, and persons of other nonwhite races gave birth to 65 live born children. 134 births showed no designation of race.

LEGITIMACY

There were 1,279 illegitimate births to mothers who were Maine residents in 1969. Illegitimate live births represented 7.4 percent of all resident live births. This marks the tenth successive year that the percentage of illegitimate live births has increased.

HOSPITAL BIRTHS

The number of resident live births in hospitals and licensed maternity homes in 1969 was 17,310 or 99.7 percent of all resident live births.

FETAL DEATHS

The number of resident fetal deaths in 1969 was 204, which was 24.5 percent less than the number in 1968. The fetal death rate was 11.8 per 1,000 live births. This is the lowest fetal death rate in the history of the state.

GESTATION

The following table shows resident fetal deaths in 1969 by length of gestation and percent of total in each group. Unreported gestation periods have been allocated for this table.

GENERAL MORTALITY

There were 10,898 deaths of Maine residents in 1969 and the crude mortality rate was 11.0. This is a 1.7 percent decrease in number and an 0.9 percent decrease in rate from 1968.

SEX

In 1969 the number of resident male deaths was 6,167 and the number of resident female deaths was 4,731. The estimated death rate among males was 12.7 per 1,000 male population and among females was 9.3 per 1,000 female population.

INFANT DEATHS

There were 342 infant deaths in Maine during 1969 and the infant death mortality rate was 19.7 per 1,000 live births. This was a 6.0 percent decrease in number and 8.7 percent decrease in rate over 1968. The infant mortality rate has decreased 21.8 percent since 1960, 36.9 percent since 1950, 62.8 percent since 1940, and 73.9 percent since 1930.

There were 266 neonatal deaths (infant deaths during the first four weeks of life) in 1969 and the neonatal mortality rate was 15.3 per 1,000 live births. This was the lowest neonatal mortality rate in the history of the State.

PERINATAL MORTALITY

The estimated perinatal mortality rate in 1969 was 26.0 perinatal deaths per 1,000 live births and fetal deaths of twenty weeks or more gestation.

The perinatal mortality rate is based on the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{Fetal deaths 20 weeks or more} + \text{neonatal deaths}}{\text{Total live births} + \text{fetal deaths 20 weeks or more}} \times 1000$$

The 1969 perinatal mortality rate is based on 192 fetal deaths of 20 or more weeks gestation and 265 neonatal deaths.

MATERNAL MORTALITY

There were 2 maternal deaths in Maine in 1969 and the maternal mortality rate was 1.2 per 10,000 live births. This is a decrease from a rate of 3.0 in 1968.

MARRIAGES

There were 10,428 marriages in Maine in 1969. This was 249 more than in 1968, and marks the tenth successive year that the number of marriages has increased. The marriage rate was 10.5 per 1,000 population. 1969 marks the eighth successive year that the marriage rate has increased, and the total number of marriages is the highest since 1947.

PREVIOUS MARITAL STATUS

There were 7,181 marriages in Maine in 1969 in which both the bride and groom were marrying for the first time. This was 130 more than the number of first marriages in 1968. 76.7 percent of the grooms and 76.4 percent of the brides were married for the first time.

DIVORCES AND ANNULMENTS

There were 3,375 divorces granted in Maine during the calendar year 1969. This was 9.3 percent more than the number of divorces granted in 1968. The crude divorce rate was 3.4 per 1,000 population. 1969 marks the eighth successive year that the divorce rate has increased. The number of marriages annulled in 1969 was 17.

SEX OF LIBELANT

The wife was granted the divorce in 2,751 or 81.5 percent of all the divorces granted.

LEGAL GROUNDS FOR DECREE

Cruelty was the legal grounds for decree in 97.4 percent of all divorces granted in Maine in 1969. Cruelty includes "cruel and abusive treatment" and "extreme cruelty".

DURATION OF MARRIAGE

The median duration of marriage before divorce among 1969 divorces was 6.5 years. The second year of marriage was the peak year during which marriages were ended by divorce.

MINOR CHILDREN

The divorced couple had one or more minor children in 2,255 or 66.8 percent of 1969 divorces. Six divorced couples had 8 or more children.

LEADING CAUSES OF DEATH

LEADING CAUSES OF DEATH

In the following table, "Life Lost" is based on expectation of life from the 1967 United States Life tables for white population. The death of an infant represents a total of 71.3 years "life lost" and the death of a person 85 years of age represents 4.7 years of "life lost."

When one examines the leading causes of death in terms of "life lost" rather than total deaths, an entirely different picture is presented. "Certain diseases of early infancy" which caused only 1.9 percent of total deaths, caused 8.4 percent of the total "life lost" in 1969 and jumped from eighth place in total deaths to fourth place in total "life lost". Congenital Anomalies jumped from fourteenth place in total deaths to seventh place in "life lost". Accidents caused only 5.1 percent of total deaths but 11.3 per cent of total "life lost". Diseases of the heart caused 42.0 percent of total deaths but only 30.0 percent of total "life lost".
