Dear Sen. Volk, Rep. Fecteau and members of the Committee:

Section 14049-K(2) of Public Law Chapter 270 requires the Board of Real Estate Appraisers to report "whether Section 1124 of the federal Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (2010) has been repealed or substantially amended by federal legislation."

As of this date, the Board is not aware of any changes to the provisions of the Dodd-Frank act regarding appraisal management companies.

Licensing in Maine became available on November 1, 2017. Currently we have received 29 applications and have issued 18 licenses.
