## INTRODUCTION

This bibliography provides a reference source for use by the members and staff of the Maine Food~~/~~and Farmland Study Commission. The bibliography has been compiled from five sources: The Maine State Library and Law Library (designated M), the Fogler Library at the University of Maine at Orono (designated F), a literature search by Vern House (H), a collection of materials that are available at the Maine Department of Agriculture (A), and a UMO Serial Publication (SP). To locate a publication, simply look at the letter that appears in the first line of the left hand column. In a few instances, the material has been annotated briefly.

The work of the Commission may well involve the review of literature not referenced here as the Commission focuses on particular areas. It is hoped that this bibliography will serve to indicate to the Commission what work has already been done and to assist the Commission in its initial work.

It is important to note that the Maine State Library is a member of the Federal Library Prototype Project which will be operational in the near future. This project will enable the library to conduct searches on a variety of subject matters and may be an excellent resource for the Commission's use.
