It is my pleasure to present the Department of Labor's annual report on compliance with the Equal Pay Law (26 MRSA, §628).

In 2016, the Department received two complaints alleging violations of the equal pay provisions of the law. After review, neither complaint resulted in substantiated violations; therefore, the Department took no further action.

As a compliance assistance tool, the Department provides an optional poster titled "Maine Equal Pay" that highlights an individual's rights under the Equal Pay Law. Additional information on this law can be found on the Department's website to include a self-audit tool kit for employers, an equal pay complaint form, and the Department's rules relating to equal pay.
