Dear Committee Co-Chairs:

Pursuant to 36 M.R.S. § 5219-QQ(4)(B), I am reporting on the revenue loss to the State of Maine as a result of the credit for major business headquarters expansions for tax years ending in 2019. There has been no revenue loss to the State as a result of the credit. The earliest a credit may be claimed is for tax years beginning in 2020.

Pursuant to 36 M.R.S. § 5219-RR(9)(C), I am reporting on the revenue loss to the State of Maine as a result of the credit for Maine shipbuilding facility investment for tax years ending in 2019. There has been no revenue loss to the State as a result of the credit. The earliest a credit may be claimed is for tax years beginning in 2020.

Pursuant to 36 M.R.S. § 5219-VV(5)(C), I am reporting on the revenue loss to the State of Maine as a result of the credit for major food processing and manufacturing facility expansion for tax years ending in 2019. There has been no revenue loss to the State as a result of the credit. The earliest a credit may be claimed is for tax years beginning in 2022.
