



AWP Complaints Received By Year




AWP Complaints By County





AWP Complaints By Species












AWP Complaints By Type








AWP Court Cases By Year


Overview of S/N Program

- Low-Income Program Designed to Assist Potential Clients who are currently receiving:
 - MaineCare (formerly Medicaid)
 - TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families)
 - Food Stamps
 - SSI (Supplemental Security Income)
 - SSD (Social Security Disability)
- If not currently enrolled in one of the above programs, income must be low enough to qualify for one of these programs.
- Income is based on Federal Poverty Guidelines.




Total Number of Animals Altered FY 04-05





On Line Dog Licensing Program Created 2003




On Line Dog Licensing Sales By Year




Animal Welfare Program Funding by Fiscal Year




Revenue By Fiscal Year




Breakdown of Major Revenue Sources By Year


- April 2004 Proposed Rule Hearing Cancelled.

- April 23, 2006 Deadline to send finalized Rule to Secretary of State's Office for publication.




