The Legislature

Size

The Senate has 35 members. The House has 151 members. From the turn of the century until the mid-seventies, the Republicans dominated both branches of the Legislature with rare exceptions. In 1974, the Democrats gained control of the House of Representatives and have maintained their majority since then. There are 97 Democrats and 54 Republicans in the House currently. In 1982, Democrats took over in the Senate. The Senate currently has 22 Democrats and 13 Republicans.

Representation

Each Senator represents a district including approximately 32,100 constituents. Each House member represents a district which has approximately 7,500 people. Originally Senators were elected at large from each county with numbers according to population; since the 104th Legislature they have been elected by district. Until the 109th Legislature, House members from some of the larger communities in the state were elected at large from their districts. Now there are 151 individual districts throughout the State. Some Senate districts cross county lines and town and city lines as do some House districts.

Election of Legislative Leadership

The Senate and House each elects its presiding officer. The Majority Leaders and Assistants are chosen by the members of the respective majority and minority parties in each branch. The Senate elects its own Secretary and Assistant Secretary and the House elects its own Clerk and Assistant Clerk. The President of the Senate is Charles P. Pray. Speaker of the House is John L. Martin. Nancy Randall Clark is Majority Leader in the Senate; the Assistant is Dennis L. Dutremble. The Minority Leader in the Senate is Charles M. Webster. The Assistant Minority Leader is Pamela Lee Cahill. The House Majority Leader is Dan A. Gwadosky; the Majority Party Whip is Joseph W. Mayo. The Minority Leader in the House is Walter E. Whitcomb and the Assistant Minority Leader is Francis C. Marsano. Secretary of the Senate is Joy J. O'Brien; Assistant Secretary is Pamela E. Lovley; Clerk of the House is Edwin H. Pert and Assistant Clerk is Deborah Bedard Wood.

The Senate and the House jointly ballot to elect the constitutional officers, who include Secretary of State, the Attorney General, and

the Treasurer, all elected to two-year terms. The Senate and House also jointly elect the State Auditor for a four-year term. Usually the constitutional officers are members of the Majority party in the total Legislature. G. William Diamond is Secretary of State. The Attorney General is Michael E. Carpenter. The Treasurer is Samuel D. Shapiro. Auditor is Rodney L. Scribner, whose term expires in 1993.

Staff

The Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House recommend appointments of their staffs to the President of the Senate and to the Speaker of the House. The House maintains a staff of about 30 persons when the Legislature is in session. The Senate maintains a staff of close to 30 when the Legislature is in session. The Secretary and Clerk serve on a full-time basis, reducing their staffs when the Legislature is not in session.

Both the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House are entitled to employ a secretary and one aide or such staff as may be ordered by either branch. The Majority and Minority Leaders are authorized by statutes to have partisan aides.

Seat Assignments

Seats in the Senate are assigned by the Majority Leader with returning Senators having priority, then new members of the Majority and then the Minority.

Seats in the House are assigned on the basis of seniority. Requests from legislators are taken into consideration when making assignments. Physical disabilities play a role in House seat assignments.

Committee Assignments

Legislative committees generally have 13 members, 10 from the House and three from the Senate. The committees are co-chaired by a Senator and a Representative. The President and Speaker make the appointments, asking for recommendations of the Majority and Minority Leaders.

Committee Responsibilities

Joint standing legislative committees meet when there are bills available for which they hold public hearings. Committee chairs jointly schedule the meetings with the concurrence of the committees. A clerk to each committee is hired by agreement between the Senate and the House chairs.

Committee Powers

Each committee has the power to schedule public hearings on all bills, to study legislation referred to it by the Legislature, and subject to legislative and Legislative Council approval, to study problems both during the session and between sessions. In addition to holding hearings on bills, committees may suggest amendments to bills; they may also redraft bills. They report bills out of committee: ought to pass, ought not to pass, leave to withdraw, ought to pass as amended, or ought to pass in new draft. Bills reported out of committee unanimously ought not to pass are not considered by the House and Senate. Dissent by one committee member from an ought not to pass may force legislative discussion on any document. Bills may also be reported out in divided form, with some members favoring the legislation and some not favoring it or favoring it in different form. Divided reports usually mean that the bill is debated on the floor of each body.

Committee Workloads

The number of bills assigned to committees varies, with some committees hearing more than 200 bills in the course of the two-year sessions. In the 114th Legislature, for example, the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary considered 209 bills; the Taxation Committee, 208; the State and Local Government Committee, 212; the Energy and Natural Resources Committee, 228; and the Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs, 360. Added together, all the bills in the first regular session can number nearly 2,000 with an additional 500 or 600 in the second regular session.

Legislative Session

The first regular session convenes on the first Wednesday in December after the State election. Adjournment is mandatory not later than the third Wednesday in June of the odd numbered years. However, during both the first and second regular sessions the Legislature may vote up to two short extensions when necessary. The second regular session convenes the first Wednesday after the first Tuesday in the even numbered year and must adjourn not later than the third Wednesday in April. The Legislature can meet in special session on the call of the Governor. It can also call itself into session with the consent of the majority of each political party, all members having been polled.

Legislative Pay

Legislators are paid \$10,500 for the first session and \$7,500 for the second session, receiving a paycheck every other week. In addi-

tion, they receive per diem expenses of up to \$70—\$32 for meals, and \$38 for lodging or up to \$38 for actual mileage in lieu of lodging. The President of the Senate and Speaker of the House each receive 50% more salary than their colleagues. The Majority and Minority leaders each receive 25% more salary than their colleagues and the Assistant Majority and Assistant Minority leaders receive 12 1/2% more salary.

Senators receive \$1,000 and Representatives receive \$750 annually for constituent services. When called into special session, they are paid \$100 for each day, plus expense allowances similar to those which they receive during the regular session. If legislative committees meet when the legislature is not in session, legislators are paid \$55 for each day, plus a meal allowance of \$32 and a housing or mileage allowance to cover actual expenses.

Legislative Facilities

The Senate and House each have retiring rooms. The Senate retiring room is on the fourth floor. The House has a retiring room on the third floor and lockers on the first floor. There is also a Legislative Lounge on the fourth floor with kitchen facilities. Members of both the House and Senate share the 4th floor Legislative Lounge.

Other Legislative Privileges

Each legislator may use statewide telephone service maintained by state government. There is an incoming WATS line on which legislators may call. Postage is available in reasonable amounts for the mailing of reports and documents. Legislators who use legislative license plates may park in reserved State House areas. These reserved plates cost each legislator \$2.00; legislators must pay excise and registration fees. While en route to the Legislature or from the Legislature to their homes, legislators may not be detained by law officers; they can, however, be cited to appear in court at a later time.

There is a legislative post office, where legislators receive their mail daily. Senators' mail is delivered to their desks; House members pick theirs up at the boxes.

The address for writing Senators is State House Station #3, Augusta, Maine, 04333-0003; House members can be written to at State House Station #2, Augusta, Maine 04333-0002. First class mail is forwarded by the Clerk of the House and Senate Secretary to members when the Legislature is not in session, or when a legislator is absent for a particular reason.

Senators may be reached through the Office of the Secretary of the

Senate at 289-1540. Representatives may be reached through the Office of the Clerk of the House at 289-1400. There are toll-free incoming numbers where citizens can leave their names for call back by legislators. The House number is 1-800-423-2900 and the Senate number is 1-800-423-6900. The Legislature also has two telephone devices for the deaf. The number for the House is 289-4469 and the number for the Senate is 289-1583.

Legislative Support Services

There are other legislative support services. The Office of the Revisor of Statutes assists legislators in drafting legislation and prepares their bills in final form.

Legislative assistants are assigned to each committee to do research for the committee and to draft amendments or redrafts of bills, or new bills ordered by the committee. These assistants are attached to the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis.

An excellent Law and Legislative Reference Library on the second floor of the State House is available to all legislators and to the public. It contains a great deal of reference material for use in drafting bills or preparing reports or speeches.

Legislators may call on state department heads for information and special assistance. Legislators may also contact the Chancellor of the University of Maine System for information about the University. Additionally, Senators and Representatives can call on the office of the Clerk of the House and office of the Secretary of the Senate for special assistance.

The Governor maintains a liaison staff which can work with legislators and arrange appointments with the Governor as necessary.

Rules

The Senate and the House each establish their own rules. Usually this means adopting the rules of the previous Legislature with some modifications. There are also joint rules which apply to both sides. It is useful to members to be reasonably familiar with the rules, as it facilitates effectiveness in debate and in voting procedures. Any member not familiar with a particular rule may ask the chair (President or Speaker) a procedural question about it.

Voting

Most votes require no effort, as a great deal of legislation does not require debate and can be enacted or "killed" under the gavel of the President or Speaker. Senators or Representatives may request a

"division," which means a vote if they do not wish to see the legislation enacted or denied under the gavel. Legislators also have the right to request a roll call. To have a roll call vote requires approval by 1/5 of those present and voting in either body. A roll call places the vote of each member on the record.

First action of either body is usually to refer a bill to a standing committee. Second action of either body usually consists of considering a committee report on a piece of legislation. Bills are in their most amendable form after their second reading, although they can be amended at other times. If a bill receives a positive report from a committee, it receives its first reading usually after acceptance of the committee report. Bills are assigned for a second reading on the next legislative day. Final step in the voting process is enactment, once the bill has been printed in final form and prepared for the signature of the Speaker of the House, President of the Senate, and Governor.

When the Senate and the House disagree sharply on a bill, a Committee of Conference can be sought. It would contain three persons each from the Senate and the House. The Committee of Conference often recommends a compromise and the bill is presented with a proposed amendment to both bodies. It may not be further amended.

Maine is one of three states which have joint standing committees, consisting of members from the Senate and from the House. Most other states have separate Senate and House committees, which can lengthen and complicate the legislative process.

Tools

The Senate and the House each prepares its own calendar daily which is available at 8:00 each morning, so that legislators may know what items of legislation will be acted upon that day. Copies are available to the public and may be picked up at the Clerk's Office and the Senate Office. A schedule of committee hearings is put out weekly by the office of the Senate President.

A weekly legislative report is issued by the Clerk of the House when the Legislature is in session; it lists every bill introduced in either branch. A weekly legislative calendar is issued by the Clerk of the House.

Legislative Council conducts routine business of the Legislature when the Legislature is not in session, but does not enact legislation. The Legislative Council includes the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House, the Majority and Minority Leaders, the Assistant Majority and Minority Leaders in the Senate, the House Majority Whip and the House Assistant Minority Leader, and totals 10 in number.
