Pursuant to 5 M.S.R.A., section 12023, the Sunrise County Economic Council (SCEC) is pleased to submit the 2021-2022 Quasi-Independent State Entities Report to the Legislature on behalf of the Washington County Development Authority (WCDA) due by February 1, 2023.

SCEC is a private, nonprofit, federally recognized economic development organization which works to create jobs and wealth in Washington County. We provide staff support for the WCDA and are partnering with the Authority in its effort to redevelop the former U.S. Navy base in Cutler.

As indicated in the enclosed report, the WCDA procured GR Roofing LLC to replace the roof on the Base's Chapel Shop and Workshop. Seavee & Mahar Engineering were procured to take samples for hazardous materials for the DEP and EPA. WCDA has not make any significant, contributions or changes to policies and procedures in the past year. In March 2015, the Authority was given the commercial side of the former base by Cutler North, LLC, a private developer that had failed in its redevelopment effort. The WCDA now owns roughly 20 acres and five commercial buildings comprising 75,000 square feet. The Authority is working to bring these facilities back into productive use.
