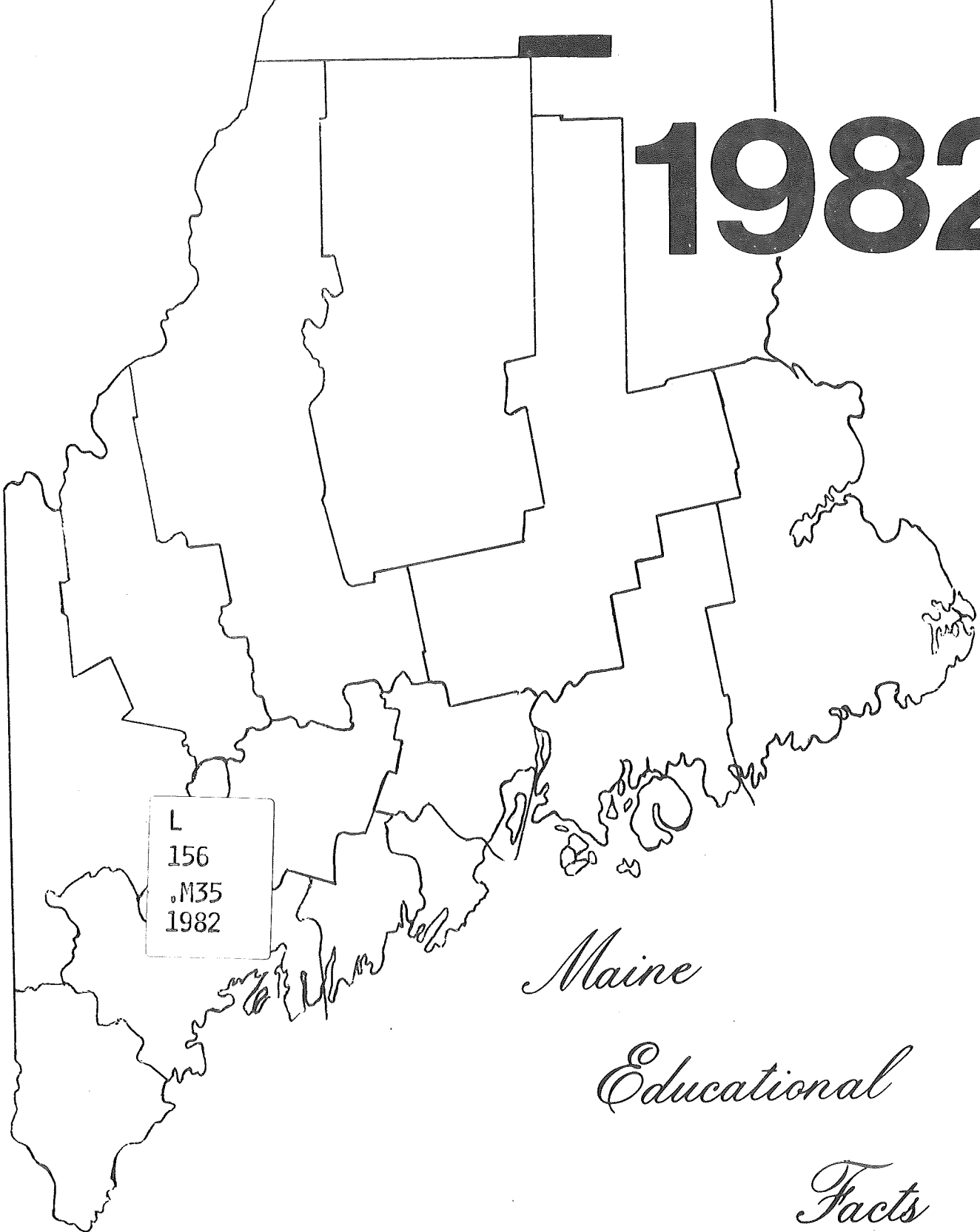

SUMMARY OF

"MAINE EDUCATIONAL FACTS"

Title 20 - Chapter 105 § 911. "Education is compulsory for pupils from age 7 to 17."

In 1981 Maine had a Fall Enrollment of 216,313 enrolled in 772 public schools (619 elementary, 103 secondary and 50 combined elementary and secondary). These students were taught by 12,829 staff members. A total of 15,836 students were enrolled in private schools, (75 elementary, 22 secondary, and 56 combined elementary and secondary) and were taught by 1,090 teachers.

In 1982 Maine had a Fall Enrollment of 211,986 students enrolled in 773 public schools (619 elementary, 105 secondary, and 49 combined elementary and secondary). These students were taught by 12,338 staff members. In the spring of 1982 the net enrollment totalled to 215,965 students. A total of 15,363 students were enrolled in 124 private schools (67 elementary, 23 secondary, and 34 combined elementary and secondary) and were taught by 1,080 teachers.

Maine's 496 towns are now divided into 73 school administrative districts with 278 towns, 34 cities and towns under individual supervision, 22 towns under district superintendents and agents of the commissioner and 12 community school districts with 37 towns, leaving 125 towns in 35 unions.

The cost of public education continues to rise. The cost per pupil excluding transportation, capital outlay and debt service, was \$1,468.71 per elementary and \$1,820.18 per secondary.

Much has been done to encourage young people to complete their secondary education and advance into post-secondary education. Of the 17,013 high school graduates (15,186 public and 1,827 private) in 1982, 45.7% of the public high school graduates and 67% of the private high school graduates continued their education--a combined percentage of 48.0%. Approximately 70% of these are continuing their education in Maine institutions. Of the 67,450 secondary students, there were 2,599 dropouts which gave Maine a 3.9% dropout rate for the 1981-82 school year.
