Hypodermic Apparatus Exchange Programs Report for 2004

Maine law, 22 MRSA c.252-A, sec. 1341 Hypodermic Apparatus Exchange Programs requires the Bureau of Health to file an annual report to the Legislature's Judiciary and Health and Human Services Committees on the status of exchange programs certified under this section. The required information is contained below.

Certified Hypodermic Apparatus Exchange Programs in Maine: There were four certified Hypodermic Apparatus Exchange Programs in Maine in 2005. The City of Portland, located in Portland was certified in November 1998, Down East AIDS Network, located in Ellsworth, was certified in September 2000, the Eastern Maine AIDS Network, located in Bangor, was certified in March 2002 and PreventionWorks Harm Reduction Services, located in Lewiston, was certified in January 2004. The City of Portland and the Eastern Maine AIDS Network have been in continuous operation since shortly after certification. Down East AIDS Network is not currently operating a program. PreventionWorks Harm Reduction Services had to reapply for certification after the agency merged with another provider of similar services in July; therefore, they only operated from January through July. For agency specific data on the City of Portland's, Eastern Maine AIDS Network's and PreventionWorks Harm Reduction Services' Hypodermic Apparatus Exchange Programs, please see Attachments A, B and C respectively.
