Maine law, 22 MRSA c.252-A, sec. 1341 <u>Hypodermic Apparatus Exchange Programs</u> requires the Maine Center for Disease Control to file an annual report to the Legislature's Judiciary and Health and Human Services Committees on the status of the exchange programs certified under this section. The required information is contained below.

<u>Certified Hypodermic Apparatus Exchange Programs in Maine:</u> There were five certified hypodermic Apparatus Exchange Programs in Maine in 2009. The City of Portland, located in Portland was certified in September 1998; Down East AIDS Network, located in Ellsworth, was certified in September 2000; Eastern Maine AIDS Network, located in Bangor, was certified in March 2002; Frannie Peabody Center, located in Portland was certified in July 2008; HealthReach Harm Reduction (formerly known as Dayspring AIDS Support Services), located in Augusta, was certified in December 2004.
