Summary of the activities of the board or commission related to accomplishing its mission in 2013: Panel approved LOI from National Grid/Emera (applicant) in late 2012 for a proposed 1100 MW underground transmission line from Orrington, Maine to Tewksbury, MA (230 miles) delivering northern New England wind and other resources into the NEMA/Boston Load center. Initial fee of \$10,000 was accepted from applicant in early 2013 as the next step in process to use the corridor for energy infrastructure. PUC chair Tom Welch updated panel on 1) other transmission projects underway in the region, as well as those in the development stage, and 2) procurement activities related to transmission. Legislative proposals discussed that would reallocate potential revenue from the corridor. IRP chair reviewed enacted bills LD 1517 and LD 1559, which change the panel membership and reallocate potential corridor revenue. Panel discussed notifying EUT committee of resulting conflict with existing federal rules regarding allocation of corridor revenues. Discussed ongoing progress of regional efforts to procure large scale hydropower and electricity generated from renewable sources, which would affect the need for additional transmission and the potential value of the corridor. Developed draft RFP for an appraiser(s) to assist panel in identifying a range of values for the use of the 1-95/295/Maine turnpike statutory corridor for energy infrastructure.
