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2019 - A Year of Success

InforME provides a variety of resources to citizens and businesses allowing for easy access to information and resources through one-stop services, convenient notification options, and excellent customer service. After two decades in partnership with the State of Maine, InforME continues to focus on combining advanced technologies with user-friendly design to meet the service needs of citizens, businesses and state government.

The State of Maine first adopted the concept for a self-funded digital government portal in 1997 with the creation of the InforME legislation, a unique state initiative resulting in the creation of Maine.gov. Now celebrating its 20th year, InforME continues to find innovative ways to provide access to services to the citizens of Maine.

Maine.gov Milestones

2019 was a record year for InforME service usage, with more than 51,000,000 visits to Maine.gov website content, and over 1.2 million securely processed credit and debit card transactions. In addition, over 175,000 vehicle registrations were renewed online across 256 participating municipalities, and more than 200,000 hunting and fishing license authorities were purchased online.

This year also saw the continued adoption and expansion of a content management system (CMS) for website development and maintenance. A content management system leverages modern technologies and completely enhances the website creation and editing process for state program administrators. In total, 18 new sites were launched in the platform including the Office of the Governor, Department of Economic and Community Development, and the Office of Policy Innovation and Future. A website redesign of the Department of Health and Human Services and the Office of Professional and Financial Regulation are also under way with deployments scheduled in 2020.

Innovative Solutions and Enhancements

2019 also saw the deployment of a new service for the Bureau of Corporations, Elections and Commissions. The Boards and Commissions Annual Report Filing and Management service allows the agency to create and manage boards and also assists clerks of the boards with filing reports online and maintaining board information.

Express Forms, an online form building tool, was also introduced this year. This enterprise tool streamlines the process for creating simple electronic forms. To date, forms have been created across seven agencies, including the Office of Governor Mills Internship Application Form, Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry Trade Show Reservation Request, Tree Ailment Reporting Form, and Maine Open Farm Day Photo Submission.

Looking Forward to 2020

In the coming year, InforME will expand access to state and local government services and information by leveraging chatbot technologies and by investing in enterprise solutions that allow program administrators to quickly transition new services online. With the deployment of several new services and websites already on the roadmap for 2020, InforME is looking forward to another year of progress and successful achievements.

Strategic Plan Update

After two decades as the State's eGovernment service provider, InforME has reached a new level of maturity with more than 170 unique online services, a consistently award-winning Maine.gov website and a variety of enterprise solutions. This maturity, along with changes to the landscape of the Internet, brings challenges and opportunities. New strategies need to be developed in order to ensure that InforME continues to achieve its vision for serving both state government and the public.

To address these challenges and opportunities, the InforME board held its biennial strategic planning retreat in September 2017. At the retreat, board members and InforME staff discussed the key issues facing InforME and strategies to address those issues during the time period covering 2018-2020.

The group agreed that over the next two years, InforME should find ways to:

- Strengthen the message of InforME's benefits to state agencies and the public;
- Identify barriers to online service usage;
- Create user guides and demonstrations to assist users in navigating online services;
- Evaluate emerging technologies and the effect those technologies can have on digital government;
- Evaluate the existing funding and pricing models, service costs, and revise accordingly to remain self-sustaining;
- Create case studies of digital government success stories and present those to government leaders; and,
- Manage complex security concerns.

The four primary goals below provide the basis for the Strategic Plan. InforME staff and the Board must work together to:

1. Continue the long-term financial stability and viability of InforME.
2. Provide continued marketing and education to position InforME as the primary resource for online solutions for State and Local government.
3. Position InforME to proactively respond to the ever-changing landscape of Internet security threats.
4. Promote the benefits of Maine eGovernment services to both citizens and businesses.

These goals will be achieved through a concentrated focus on completing several objectives and identified strategies. The completion of these goals, objectives and strategies will further position InforME as Maine's premiere eGovernment services provider.




