SUMMARY: Authorizes Gerald Pelletier to bring civil action against State for \$3 million for alleged negligent bridge maintenance.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (S-48): maximum recovery reduced to \$1.5 million. (Adopted in maj. rept.)

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" (S-43): meximum recovery reduced to \$300,000 (Violette) (H/S Adopted)

190 AN ACT TO REQUIRE WHOLESALE MALT Danton ONTP LIQUOR PRICES TO REMAIN IN EFFECT H/S: Accepted FOR 90 DAYS

SUMMARY: Wholesale malt liquor prices must be posted with the State Liquor Commission and then may not be changed for 90 days.

SUMMARY: Restricted liquor license for public event to be held by incorporated civil organization is valid for 7 consecutive days rather than 3 days.

207 AN ACT TO PERMIT BOWLING ALLEYS TO Dillenback M-OTP(Acc.)
SELL SPIRITUOUS, VINOUS AND MALT Salsbury m-ONTP
LIQUOR H: adhered to fail. to eng.
S: eng.

SUMMARY: Permits bowling alleys of at least 12 lanes to sell spiritous, vinous and malt liquor if they meet the same standards as golf clubs, indoor tennis clubs and indoor ice skating clubs.
