SUMMARY: Governs transactions under "budget plan," to assure that purchasers received equitable treatment compared to cash customers; controls mark-up of product; requires specific disclosures and periodic statements.

913 AN ACT CONCERNING CREDIT CARD MCBREAIRTY ONTP SALES OF MOTOR FUELS VOSE

SUMMARY: Prohibits oil companies from preventing cash discounts by dealers; requires reimbursement at face value for credit purchases, without reduction for costs of credit.

301 AN ACT TO CORRECT CERTAIN SOULE (OTPA)
ERRORS IN THE MAINE CONDOMINIUM ACT (EMERGENCY)

SUMMARY: Corrects several technical errors in the Condominium Act; incorrect references, etc.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-31): Corrects technical error in the bill. (Other suggested changes were found to be statute publisher's errors, not part of current law, therefore not amendable.) (ADOPTED)

399 AN ACT RELATING TO UNREASON-BROWN A (OTP)
ABLE OR UNJUST RENT IN MOBILE (Re-refer PL 1983, c.148
HOME PARKS from Legal
Affairs)

SUMMARY: Amends the law concerning profiteering in rents to include mobile home park lot charges.

568 AN ACT RELATING TO TIME SHARES COOPER (OTP)
PL 1983, c.248

SUMMARY: Generally re-enacts current law to clarify that it is not implicitly repealed by the Condominium Act; redefines "time shares" to coincide with recent developments and one of model laws.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-153): Moves the law on time shares out of the chapter on unit ownership into its own chapter in order to assure that the law is not implicitly repealed by the condominium law. (ADOPTED)
