LD TITLE SPONSOR DISPOSITION

497 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR MCHENRY CARRYOVER EXCLUSIVE STATE FUNDING OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION

SUMMARY: Despite the title, sets up a competitive state fund for workers' compensation insurance, to be used as an alternative to private insurance and self-insurance, which would each remain available.

CROSS-REFERENCES: LD 495, LD 752 (and LD 1322, Labor Committee, providing for funded study of alternative funding mechanisms).

552 AN ACT TO AMEND THE MAINE PERKINS, A LV/WD INSURANCE GUARANTY ASSOCIA- RACINE TION ACT

SUMMARY: Brings Maine Insurance Guaranty Association (MIGA) law into greater conformity with model law of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners' (NAIC) Post-Assessment Property and Liability Insurance Guaranty Association Act; eliminates credit, surety and ocean/marine insurance from MIGA coverage; offset by insurers of contributions to MIGA against premium taxes.

AN ACT TO REDUCE OVERSIGHT
RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE
SUPERINTENDENT OF INSURANCE
WITH RESPECT TO THE MAINE
SELF-INSURANCE GUARANTEE
ASSOCIATION

SUMMARY: Removes responsibility of Superintendent of Insurance over Maine Self-Insurance Guarantee Association (MSIGA) to approve plan of operation; approve selection of board members; oversee administration of fund; approve designation of a servicing facility; hear appeals of aggrieved members from a decision of the board; and prescribe rules governing the association.

720 AN ACT TO PERMIT REAL ESTATE STEVENS (OTPA)
AGENTS TO BE CONSIDERED CASHMAN PL 1983, c.84
INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS FOR
PURPOSES OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE

SUMMARY: Excludes real estate brokers and salespeople paid solely by commission from workers' compensation definition of "employee."

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-52): Adds additional requirement of a contract evidencing independent contractor relationship. (ADOPTED)
