SUMMARY: Permits owner of a motor vehicle racing facility to pay a one-time \$250 fee for traveling amusement shows, such as auto, motorcycle and stunt shows.

- SUMMARY of LD 673: Liquor Commission would sell to agency stores at a price of 12% less than the retail price for that liquor. This increased discount was proposed to cover the costs of operating an agency store.
- SUMMARY OF NEW DRAFT of LD 1165: Agency stores must sell liquor at a price not less than the price at state retail stores and not more than a price that is 5% greater than the retail price; this allows agency stores to charge more than state stores and cover their operation costs without decreasing revenues to the General Fund.
- SENATE AMENDMENT "A" (S-24): Corrects grammatical error. (Danton) (H/S: accepted)

SUMMARY: Personal property seized during search by law enforcement agency which is not used as evidence and becomes abandoned may be sold at public auction; firearms and ammunition may be sold at auction or disposed of in any manner consistent with public safety.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-149): Limits disposition of firearms and ammunition; law enforcement agency may auction firearms to federallylicensed dealer, use them for training or destroy them (H/S: adopted).
