SUMMARY: There has been continuing controversy over the transferability of courses between campuses of the University of Maine. The bill establishes a committee to develop a uniform course numbering system and a policy to clarify and facilitate the transferability of credits. It requires the board of trustees to implement the recommendations by the fall semester of 1985.
