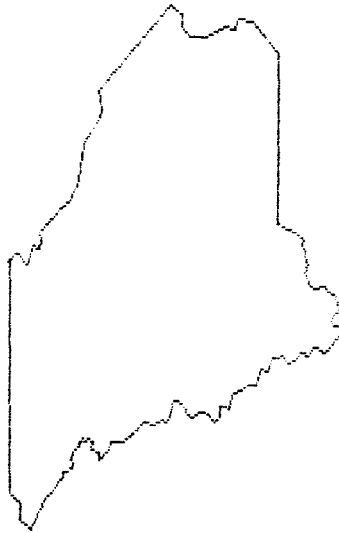

SUMMARY: A person may keep an unregistered deer at his temporary place of lodging for 7 days or until he leaves the woods whichever comes first or if he notifies a warden within 12 hours of the location of and the reason for leaving the deer in the woods.
