- SUMMARY: Removes July 1, 1983 sunset on exemption of nursing home employees from requirements of Social Worker Registration Act.
- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (S-72): Adds EMERGENCY language and extends sunset to July 1, 1985. (ADOPTED)
- 915 AN ACT TO REQUIRE SOCIAL DUTREMBLE ONTP
  WORKERS EMPLOYED BY HOSPITALS
  TO BE REGISTERED
- SUMMARY: Removes exemption of hospital workers from requirements of the Social Worker Registration Act.

### Surveyors

AN ACT TO REQUIRE NOTIFICATION TO HICHENS LV/WD ABUTTING LANDOWNERS UPON CORRECTION OR ALTERATION OF A PRIOR SURVEY

SUMMARY: Requires land surveyor to provide prior notice to abutting landowners that a survey is being undertaken; penalties include civil violation and disciplinary action on surveyor's certificate of registration. (Action being taken by board.)

## Transient Sellers

569 AN ACT TO AMEND THE STATUTES ALLEN OTPND (1487)
RELATING TO ITINERANT SELLERS

SUMMARY: Requires transient sellers to carry license or copy and present it on demand; no violation if seller subsequently provides license valid at time of summons; civil penalty.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE STATUTES (ALLEN) PL 1983, c.236
RELATING TO ITINERANT SELLERS ND of 569

SUMMARY: Issuance of individual licenses to transient sellers and employees; civil violation for failure to present; no defense for subsequently presenting license; fees increased and dedicated; new fee for employee license.
