<mark>1577</mark>	AN ACT TO AMEND THE MAINE CONSUMER CREDIT CODE	(POULIOT PRAY BENOIT CONARY) ND of 1179	PL 1983, c.384

- SUMMARY: Allows annual charge of up to \$12 on lender credit cards; limits to one fee per account; assessed at renewal or anniversary; effective January 1, 1984.
- HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" (H-230): Requires credit of fee against finance charge, as in original bill. (Racine) (Not adopted)

HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" (H-231): Reduces finance charge rate chargeable on lender credit cards from 18% annually to 16% annually. (Racine) (Not adopted)

262 AN ACT TO CONFORM MAINE HICHENS (OTPA) GARNISHMENT LAWS TO THE PL 1983, c.155 UNITED STATES CODE, TITLE 15, SECTION 1673, THE FEDERAL CONSUMER CREDIT PROTECTION ACT

- SUMMARY: Increases the amount of wages which may be garnished for support obligations.
- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (S-26): Adds exception for limits in Consumer Credit Code. (ADOPTED)
- SENATE AMENDMENT "A" (S-32): Maintains for all cases the floor on earnings not subject to garnishment of 30 times federal minimum wage. (Trafton)(ADOPTED)
- SENATE AMENDMENT "B" (S-46): Adds EMERGENCY to bill.(Pray)(Not adopted)

- SUMMARY: Transfers filing of mechanics' liens from municipal clerks to Secretary of State.
- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-72): Changes procedure, fees for filing liens to correspond to current procedures of Secretary of State; also adds fiscal note. (ADOPTED)
