AN ACT CONCERNING CONTROL OF 1615 THE CONTENT OF REBUTTALS TO MEDIA EDITORIALS

SUMMARY: Would have required a broadcasting station to provide rebuttal time to an editorial broadcast by the station.

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER Pearson 1639 OF VOTING BOOTHS REQUIRED IN

ND-LD 312 ENACT. PL 391

MAINE ELECTIONS

Requires each municipality to provide at least 1 voting booth for SUMMARY: each 150, or major fraction thereof, of qualified voters at each voting place in a general election. In other elections officials may provide fewer booths when circumstances dictate. The Secretary of State may arrange for inspections to ensure compliance.

1663 AN ACT CONCERNING EXPLANA-TIONS FOR REFERENDA QUESTIONS WHICH APPEAR ON A BALLOT

ND-LD 1059 ENACT. PL 410

SUMMARY: Requires ballot questions to be set out in clear, concise and direct language and gives the Secretary of State responsibility to establish a method of drafting to ensure readability. Establishes the order in which questions appear on the ballot. Requires ballot questions for initiative and peoples veto referenda to appear on the face of the petition.
