- SUMMARY: Revises plumber licensing categories; revises funeral service trainee license category and provides penalty for unlicensed practice; other minor changes in license laws of Hearing Aid Dealers & Fitters, Physical Therapists, Psychologists and Comm. Driver Ed. instructors.
- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (S-156):Corrects to take account of LD1076(PL 83, c.204); removes increased powers of funeral services board. (ADOPTED)
- HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-334): Corrects C"A", which removed section 5 of the bill instead of section 4. (Brannigan) (ADOPTED)

- SUMMARY: Allows greater flexibility in investing municipal funds; clarifies authority to invest in repurchase agreements, make deposits in out of state banks and contract for safekeeping and investment management services.
- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-59): Extends bill's provisions to school districts; changes some language to correspond to Banking Code; deletes requirement of disposal of repurchase agreements within 21 days, substituting requirement only of a perfect security interest. (ADOPTED)

- SUMMARY: Allows Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages to accept payment by major credit card at selected stores.
- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (S-50): Extends authority of Liquor Commission to accept credit card sales statewide. (ADOPTED)
- CROSS-REFERENCES: Resurrected in substance by LD 1780 (Governor's Bill)(SP: Martin, J) (H/S: Indef.PP). Subsequently included in Part II budget, LD 1784, Part F, Subpart 1, and enacted as PL 1983, c.477.
