Mitchell, E. PL 1983, c. 427 (new draft LD 1393)

SUMMARY: Requires prejudgment interest in civil actions to be paid from the date written notice of the cause of action is given to the defendant. If no notice is given, interest shall accrue from the date the complaint is filed.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH STANDARDS OF ACCESSIBILITY FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS IN PUBLIC HOUSING AND PLACES OF PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION Andrews PL 1983, c. 437 (new draft LD 1474)

SUMMARY: Amends the Maine Human Rights Act concerning standards of accessibility for handicapped persons in public housing and places of public accommodation. Requires that public housing constructed, remodeled or enlarged at a cost exceeding \$100,000 after January 1, 1984, must contain at least one unit for every 20 in the building that is accessible to and useable by handicapped persons and specifies the standards that are to be applied in this situation. Extends the public buildings standards of accessibility for handicapped persons to places of public accommodations constructed on or after January 1, 1984. Standards of accessibility for remodeled or renovated places of public accommodation remain the same as in current law.

1684 AN ACT TO CREATE A MAINE SENTENCING GUIDELINES COMMISSION

Connolly

P&SL 1983, c. 53 (new draft LD 1196)

SUMMARY: Establishes a commission to recommend sentencing guidelines in order to reduce disparity in sentencing and to establish just, uniform sentencing practices throughout the State in terms of length of incarceration, as well as incarceration versus probation. \$10,000 was appropriated for carrying out the purposes of this Act.

Resolve 1983, c. 40 (new draft LD 1359)

SUMMARY: Directs the Maine State Commission on the Arts and Humanities to prepare a form contract that may be used by artists seeking to protect their works of art from alteration by persons or institutions acquiring the art work. The form contract is available to any interested persons, but is particularly designed for use in the acquisition of art under the Percent for Art Act which directs the placement of art in state funded public buildings or facilities.
